These dishes were entered into contests where a panel of chefs judged each cutry to find the winning dishes in the Mango Cook-Off and Dessert Bake-Off Competitions. Besides the concessions, sample booths were also available for people to enjoy different mango dishes such as savory pickled mango, and sweet mango donnes; and

WHEREAS, local families participated in displaying the variety of mango harvests in competitions to choose the "Most Beautiful Mango", the "Biggest Mango," and he "Most Bizarre Mango." The festival included activities for the whole family to enjoy, including games and rides for the children attending, and

WHEREAS, the two (2)-day weekend festival was a success for both the vendors who participated and the community of Hilgor, inspiring more vendors and participants o join in the following years and showcase their products such as locally made jewelry, crafts, designs, appared, and more; and

Quantinalla in a special election, decided to extend the Live that (11%) Annual "Lidga Mango Festival" in three day event in 2016; and WHEREAS, in 2020, the COVID 19 Pandemic shutdown the "Haga Mango Festival" of the Pointeenth (14%) Annual "Lidga Mango Festival" and the first festival held some 2019; and "WHEREAS, the Courteenth (14%) Annual "Lidga Mango Festival" was orientably scheduled to be held from Froday. May 28, 1903, at the Lidga Mango Festival".

WHEREAS, in 2024, the Annual "Hagat Mango Festival" will be celebrating its fuffeenth year of operation and will be held from Fuday, May 24, through Sunday, May

26, 2021. The fifteenth year anniversary is a testament to the evolution of the "High Mango Festival" from its imaginal event in 2006 into a cherished tradition and much anticipated event celebrating the vibrancy of C.Lamorn heritage through culturar delights, competitions, activities, and community engagements, and WHEREAS, the "Thigh Mango Festival" serves as a platform for vendors to showcase their products and services to residents and visitors from around the world; thus,

Eleventh (11th) Annual "Hågat Mango Festival" to a three-day event in 2016; and

WHEREAS, in 2020, the COVID-19 Pandemic shutdown the "Hågat Mango Festival" for three years, making the "Hågat Mango Festival" of 2023 the Fourteenth (14th) Annual "Hågat Mango Festival", and the first festival held since 2019; and

WHEREAS, the Fourteenth (14th) Annual "Hågat Mango Festival" was originally scheduled to be held from Friday, May 26 through Sunday, May 28, 2023, at the Hågat Sagan Bisita, but due to Typhoon Mawar, was rescheduled to Friday, July 28, through Sunday, July 30, 2023. This provided the island some enjoyment during the post typhoon recovery and brought back many of the previous festivals' traditions such as the cooking competitions and numerous vendors; and

WHEREAS, in 2024, the Annual "Hågat Mango Festival" will be celebrating its fifteenth year of operation and will be held from Friday, May 24, through Sunday, May 26, 2024.
