1 BE IT RESOLVED BY I MINA'TRENTAL SIETTE NA LIHESLATURAN **GUÅHAN:** 2 WHEREAS, August 2024 recognizes nationally "Child Support Awareness 3 Month"; and 4 WHEREAS, the Office of the Attorney General's (OAG) "Love Your kids" 5 6 program involves custodial and non-custodial parents providing all forms of support for 7 their children to help them succeed in life; and 8 WHEREAS, the Attorney General's Office's "Love Your Kids" program relies on the premise that both parents naturally want their children to be as strong and well-9 adjusted as possible, and to also be better than the parents were in life; and 10 11 WHEREAS, the Attorney General's Office's role in protecting Guam's children involves not just protecting them against harm, but also ensuring that our Community's 12

children receive as much financial and emotional support that both parents can provide to them; and

WHEREAS, love is the foundation upon which Guam's children will grow and flourish into being its future leaders, entrepreneurs, teachers, business people, parents, and overall good, productive, and law-abiding citizens; and

WHEREAS, although part of the Attorney General's duty is to administer the child support guidelines to both parents to provide for Guam's children's *bare minimum* financial resources that they need to live, the Attorney General also implemented the "Love Your Kids" program that encourages both parents to give more than a bare minimum to their children so that their kids can truly succeed in life; and

WHEREAS, having both parents in a child's life is infinitely better than depriving the child of one or both of their parents in order to socialize their child, thereby helping their child understand where they come from, who they are, and help them discover the gifts and talents that they have; and

WHEREAS, the Attorney General's Access and Visitation Program supplements the resources available to both custodial and non-custodial parents to focus on their children, such as sharing custody and spending actual time with their children, and not just the money needed to raise their children; and

WHEREAS, with the recent passage of Public Law Number 37-100, the Attorney General's Office, along with other leaders has finally resolved the millions of dollars owed to unlocatable custodial parents sitting in government accounts for the past over 30 years with a solid procedure to either locate those parents, or dispose of the funds pursuant to a Judge's order so that other children may be helped; and

WHEREAS, *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* fully supports the Attorney General and his staff's efforts to unite custodial and non-custodial parents under the common and shared goal of helping their children to succeed; now therefore, be it
