WHEREAS, the Guam Community Health Centers, comprising the Northern
 Region Community Health Center (NRCHC) and the Southern Region Community
 Health Center (SRCHC), serve as vital healthcare providers, delivering comprehensive
 medical services to underserved and vulnerable populations across the island; and
 WHEREAS, the Guam Community Health Centers, which are Federally
 Qualified Health Centers, operate as multi-specialty primary care clinics. The Southern

9 Region Community Health Center (SRCHC) has been serving the community for 27

10 years since its opening in 1984, while the Northern Region Community Health Center

11 (NRCHC) was established in 1998; and

WHEREAS, the Guam Community Health Centers aim to reduce health
 disparities by providing comprehensive primary health care to the underserved,
 indigent, and uninsured populations who are most in need of assistance and least able
 to find it; and

5 WHEREAS, the NRCHC and SRCHC offer comprehensive primary healthcare, 6 acute outpatient care, and preventive services to the community. Their team, including 7 family practitioners, pediatricians, internists, nurse practitioners, and other health 8 professionals, provides essential care across various areas. Services include prenatal 9 and postpartum care, women's health (OB/GYN), well-baby care, child and adolescent 10 health, immunizations, adult care, minor surgeries, wound repair, TB testing and 11 therapy, early screening and diagnostic testing for children, family planning, cancer and 12 communicable disease screening and treatment, as well as chronic disease management; 13 and

WHEREAS, the Guam Community Health Centers operate under the auspices
of the Bureau of Primary Care Services (BPCS), ensuring a unified and strategic
approach to public healthcare delivery in Guam; and

WHEREAS, the Administrator of the Bureau of Primary Care Services also
serves as the Executive Director of both the NRCHC and SRCHC, providing consistent
leadership and oversight to the operations and initiatives of the Community Health
Centers; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of the Guam Community Health Centers assumes critical governance and fiduciary responsibilities, guiding the strategic direction and ensuring the financial stability of both the NRCHC and SRCHC; and

WHEREAS, the Guam Community Health Centers play a crucial role in improving public health outcomes, particularly for the island's underserved populations, by providing accessible, high-quality healthcare services, including preventive care, chronic disease management, and wellness programs; and WHEREAS, the dedicated staff and leadership of the NRCHC and SRCHC have
 demonstrated an unwavering commitment to serving the healthcare needs of Guam's
 residents, contributing to the overall well-being and health equity of the community;
 and
