9 WHEREAS, Regine Tugade OLY attained the rank of Lieutenant (junior grade)

10 in the United States Navy, and served with distinction as a Surface Warfare Officer,

bringing honor to Guam through her dedication and commitment to her country; and

13 having graduated from John F. Kennedy High School in 2016; and

WHEREAS, Regine Tugade OLY successfully earned a Bachelor of Science
 degree in Political Science from the United States Naval Academy in 2020; and

WHEREAS, Regine Tugade OLY is currently pursuing advanced degrees, including a Master of Science in Business Analytics and a Master of Business Administration (MBA) from Jacksonville University, further exemplifying her dedication to academic and professional excellence; and

WHEREAS, Regine Tugade OLY is an esteemed member of the Guam Track and
Field Association Board, demonstrating her ongoing commitment to the development
of athletics in Guam; and

WHEREAS, Regine Tugade has been a dedicated Guam National Track and
 Field athlete since 2012, consistently showcasing her talent and determination on both
 national and international stages; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Tugade's athletic prowess was evident early on, as she earned
multiple All-Island track gold medals, was a member of three All-Island Team
Champions in track, and also played varsity volleyball and basketball during her high
school years at John F. Kennedy High School; and

WHEREAS, Regine Tugade OLY excelled as a collegiate athlete, competing in
 NCAA Division I track and field at the United States Naval Academy, where she served
 as team captain 2019-2020 and broke three records during her studies there; and

WHEREAS, Regine Tugade OLY holds ten Guam National Records in various track and field events, including the 100m, 200m, 400m, Long Jump, Triple Jump, Women's 4x400m relay, and Mixed 4x400m relay in outdoor competitions, and the 60m, 200m, and Long Jump in indoor competitions; and

WHEREAS, Regine Tugade OLY is a three-time Olympian, qualifying through
 successive competitive events to represent Guam with pride in the Rio 2016, Tokyo
 2021, and Paris 2024 Olympic Games; and

WHEREAS, Regine Tugade OLY brought global recognition to our island through her advancement in the Paris 2024 Olympic Games, as Guam's first female

Olympic contestant in any sport to compete beyond preliminary qualifying rounds, a
 significant athletic accomplishment; and
