WHEREAS, Inetnon Gefpå'go focuses on being a platform that renews identity in colonial structures, especially when dealing with crisis, trauma and social pressures; and

WHEREAS, for twenty-two (22) years, Inetnon Gefpå'go Chamorro Performing Arts Academy has developed Chamoru cultural arts youth practitioners who

demonstrate a passion for their culture and can communicate it through arts with a global perspective; and

WHEREAS, Inetnon Gefpå'go Cultural Arts Program has been awarded the Lewis Prize for Music 2024, Accelerator Award, a designation shared with only three (3) other organizations, nationwide, along with \$500,000 funding which the organization plans to use to expand their cultural arts program; and

WHEREAS, founded in 2017 by philanthropist Daniel R. Lewis and Chief Executive Officer Dalouge Smith, the Lewis Prize supports exemplary leaders across the United States who use music for positive and equitable systems change; and

WHEREAS, The Accelerator Award provide multi-year support to enable leaders and organizations to make sustained progress toward ambitious community change initiatives that align with The Lewis Prize for Music's values and vision; and

WHEREAS, funding from the award is to help give young people access to highquality music learning and performance and to create opportunities that will help them mature into thriving individuals; and
