WHEREAS, Dr. Ramel Asuncion Carlos is a board-certified neurologist with extensive expertise in general and pediatric neurology, who has been serving Guam since 2006 as the CEO and General Neurologist at The Neurology Clinic in Tamuning, Guam; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Carlos is a Diplomate of the American Board of Neurology and Psychiatry and the American Board of Disability Analysts, along with holding the designation of Civil Surgeon for U.S. Immigration, underscoring his commitment to upholding high standards in clinical and disability medicine; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Carlos has been instrumental in advancing mental health services as Medical Director and Head of the Transcranial Magnetic Stimulation Clinic for the Todu Guam Foundation, where he has served since April 2023, working to enhance mental health care access and treatment for residents of Guam; and

1 WHEREAS, Dr. Carlos holds multiple critical roles, including as a Veteran's 2 Disability Analyst and Social Security Administration Disability Examiner, offering his 3 expertise to assist veterans and individuals with disabilities in receiving necessary 4 evaluations and support; and 5 WHEREAS, Dr. Carlos has an impressive academic background, earning his 6 Doctorate of Medicine from Far Eastern University in Manila, Philippines, and further 7 training in pediatrics, neurology, and neurophysiology at Wake Forest University 8 Baptist Medical Center, North Carolina, where he held senior roles and received 9 multiple awards for his research; and 10 WHEREAS, Dr. Carlos has garnered numerous accolades throughout his career, 11 including the "Angels of Guam" award from the Guam Pacific Daily News in 2019 for 12 his philanthropic contributions and a Congressional Recognition in 2016 for 13 outstanding service to Guam; and 14 **WHEREAS,** Dr. Carlos is a dedicated community volunteer, serving as a mentor 15 for the Health Opportunity and Medical Exposure (H.O.M.E.) Program for premedical 16 students in Guam, a member of the Governor's Advisory Board for the COVID-19 Pandemic Task Force, and a mentor in Guam's public schools, advocating for youth 17 18 health and wellness; and 19 WHEREAS, Dr. Carlos has significantly advanced medical knowledge and 20 research, founding the Guam Medical Association Journal in 2019, and publishing 21 multiple research articles, including studies on strokes, cognitive impairment, and 22 epilepsy, impacting both local and international medical communities; and 23 WHEREAS, Dr. Carlos's commitment to knowledge-sharing and public health 24 awareness is evident through his publications, including books on aging, caregiving, 25 heart disease, and stroke prevention, which he has freely distributed to benefit the 26 community; now therefore, be it
