## BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF I MINA'TRENTAL SIETTE NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:

3 WHEREAS, the Guam Diabetes Association (GDA) is celebrating its 25th 4 Annual Diabetes Conference in 2024 and its partners, including the Guam Nurses Association (GNA), the Department of Public Health and Social Services (DPHSS), 5 6 and the University of Santo Tomas Alumni Organization of Guam (USTAOG), marking 7 a significant milestone in its commitment to improving the health and well-being of the 8 people of Guam, especially those most vulnerable to diabetes and its complications; and 9 **WHEREAS,** this year's conference theme, "The Sweet Heart and Brain Teaser" of Diabetes," reflects the complex nature of diabetes management and emphasizes the 10 importance of caring for both the physical and cognitive health impacts of diabetes, 11 12 recognizing that diabetes affects not only the body but also mental well-being; and

WHEREAS, the mission of the Guam Diabetes Association is to improve access to quality care for all, with a focused effort on reaching those most impacted by the burden of diabetes to reduce mortality, morbidity, and healthcare costs associated with uncontrolled diabetes and its related complications; and

WHEREAS, diabetes continues to be a significant public health challenge for Guam, with prevalence rates that far exceed the national average due to various factors, including genetic predispositions, lifestyle habits, and limited access to healthcare resources in certain areas. As of 2022, the prevalence of type 2 diabetes on Guam is 21.6%, compared to 10.8% in the United States (as of 2020), reflecting the urgent need for enhanced diabetes care, education, and prevention efforts on the island; and

WHEREAS, diabetes-related complications, including heart disease, kidney failure, nerve damage, and vision loss, have a substantial impact on the lives of individuals and families on Guam, often resulting in reduced quality of life and increased healthcare needs. This high prevalence places a significant burden on Guam's healthcare system, as diabetes management costs continue to rise with the growing number of cases; and

WHEREAS, the Guam Diabetes Association has been steadfast in organizing community programs, public education campaigns, and outreach events aimed at increasing diabetes awareness and prevention, helping residents make informed decisions about their health, and facilitating access to essential resources for diabetes management; and

WHEREAS, through initiatives such as free screenings, counseling, support groups, educational workshops, and collaborations with healthcare providers, the GDA continues to empower individuals to manage their condition effectively and adopt healthier lifestyles; and

WHEREAS, the GDA's Annual Diabetes Conference has grown over the years into a key gathering of healthcare professionals, diabetes educators, patients, and community leaders, providing a platform to discuss the latest advancements in diabetes care, share best practices, and strengthen Guam's health network; and
