WHEREAS, Chief Burrier's journey began over four decades ago when he enlisted in the United States Air Force, graduating as an Honor Graduate from the Air Force Fire Academy in 1985 and training in both structural and airport crash firefighting. His service at Anderson Air Force Base ignited his love for Guam, leading him to make Guam his permanent home and apply to the Guam Fire Department at the end of his enlistment; and

**WHEREAS,** in 1989, Chief Burrier joined GFD as part of the 11th Fire Cycle and has since held a variety of roles, including assignments in Emergency Medical Services (EMS) and Rescue Operations. He was promoted to Fire Captain in 1997

and later to Assistant Fire Chief in 2015, where he has commanded various bureaus,

including the Operations Bureau, EMS/Rescue Bureau, Training Bureau, and

currently, the Special Operations Bureau; and

WHEREAS, Chief Burrier's commitment to excellence and his leadership have shaped multiple aspects of GFD's services. From overseeing quality assurance and training to developing essential operating procedures and regulations, his contributions have strengthened daily ambulance and rescue operations, impacting countless lives across Guam; and

WHEREAS, beyond his operational responsibilities, Chief Burrier has been instrumental in training the next generation of firefighters. He pioneered the Fire Recruit Physical Agility Test (FRPAT), spearheaded the transition to National Registry Certification for GFD, and advanced Paramedic training and certification through partnerships with the Guam Department of Labor, Guam Community College (GCC), and the School of EMS; and

WHEREAS, his dedication to education extends to his role as an adjunct instructor at GCC, where he has taught Emergency Medical Technician (EMT) courses for two decades, as well as instructional roles in emergency response training across the Pacific region. He currently serves as Chairperson of the Guam Trauma Regional Advisory Council, Vice Chairperson of the Emergency Medical Services Commission, and as a member of the GCC Nursing and Allied Health Advisory Board; and

WHEREAS, Chief Burrier holds an associate degree in Fire Science from GCC and is currently pursuing his studies in Fire Management at Columbia Southern University. Over his career, he has earned numerous certifications, including National Registry Advanced Emergency Medical Technician, Instructor in Advanced Cardiac Life Support, and FEMA Incident Command Systems Instructor,
