## 1 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF *I* 2 *MINA'TRENTAI SIETTE NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN*:

WHEREAS, in 2012, "Giving Tuesday" launched with a big goal in mind and their commitment to a core set of values with an open distributed leadership model, and a belief in transformational partnership that set on course the building of the first global generosity movement and the first global day of celebration open to anyone and everyone around the world, to build a better world where generosity and kindness is part of everyday life; and

annually on the Tuesday after Thanksgiving and the events of Black Friday and Cyber
Monday to kick off the holiday giving season; and

WHEREAS, in 2018, Guam adopted the #GivingTuesday movement and
participated globally, for the first time, along with eleven (11) other countries
worldwide; and

WHEREAS, Guam's core values and the foundation of our culture encourage community and collaboration and, with our *Inafa'maolek* spirit having been passed down to us from our parents and grandparents, we find a way to get together and support those in need; and

WHEREAS, in recognizing #GivingTuesday, we join the global call to action
with charities, families, businesses, community centers, students, reatilers and more
come together to celebrate and encourage generosity; and

WHEREAS, the KUAM Careforce Team visits schools, businesses and other organizations; collects donations for their K is for Kindness campaign, providing nonperishable food and unused toys to the Salvation Army and Catholic Social Services as well as baby necessities for the Department of Social Services Foster Care; and

WHEREAS, #GivingTuesdayGuam provides a framework for people to choose
their best way to contribute to the community and will provide an opportunity to share
their giving stories; now therefore, be it
