Relative to recognizing Benedicto "Benjie" Yuson Diola for his contributions to the performing arts on Guam; and to congratulate his recognition as the inaugural recipient of the "Haligi Laureate" Award at the Guam Philharmonic Foundation's 2024 Saint Cecilia Music Gala.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF *I*MINA'TRENTALSIETTE NA LIHESLATURAN GUÂHAN:

- WHEREAS, the Guam Philharmonic Foundation, Incorporated presents the 2024 Saint Cecilia Music Gala, its third annual celebration, to honor excellence in the arts and community contributions; and
 - WHEREAS, the highlight of the 2024 Gala is the presentation of the inaugural "Haligi Laureate" Award to Benedicto "Benjie" Yuson Diola, recognizing his pioneering work and unwavering commitment to the performing arts, which have inspired generations of local artists and elevated the performing arts community in Guam since the 1970s; and
 - WHEREAS, the "Haligi Laureate" designation is intended to be seldomly awarded and reserved only for the most deserving community figures who have distinguished themselves through significant contributions that have propelled the musical arts on Guam; and
- WHEREAS, Benedicto "Benjie" Yuson Diola, a renowned Filipino theater director, thespian, choreographer, designer, producer, and playwright, has made

1 significant contributions to the performing arts, earning acclaim in Guam, Cebu City,

2 Cagayan de Oro, Iligan City, and beyond; and

WHEREAS, Benjie's artistic journey began during his formative years at Colegio de la Inmaculada Concepción, where he acted in school plays and studied ballet under the guidance of mentors such as Montserrat Resano, Fe Sala-Villarica, and Justo Montemayor, whose inspiration shaped his illustrious career; and

WHEREAS, his directorial debut, *The Evil Eye* (1973), an original dance drama, marked the beginning of a prolific career that spanned decades and included international show credits such as *Pippin*, *Oliver*, *The King and I, Jesus Christ Superstar*, *West Side Story*, *and Fiddler on the Roof*, among others, solidifying his reputation as a visionary in theater; and

WHEREAS, Benjie relocated to Guam in 1976, where he became a prominent figure in the performing arts, directing plays, musicals, and cultural presentations for private schools, community organizations, and government-sponsored events, including the world premieres of Chamorro originals like *Guahu Taotao Tano* and *I Lihenden Duendes*, and major spectacles such as the Micronesian Games and the South Pacific Games ceremonies; and

WHEREAS, throughout his career, Benjie has been a devoted mentor to aspiring artists, fostering creativity and passion in theater while earning multiple accolades, including the Governor's Art Awards and Lifetime Achievement Award in 1994 from Guam and Outstanding Citizen in the Field of Performing Arts from Cebu in 1973 and 1996, reflecting his enduring impact on the cultural landscapes of both Guam and the Philippines; and

WHEREAS, Benjie's enduring legacy has profoundly impacted the performing arts community, paving the way for the Guam Philharmonic Foundation, Inc. to thrive and inspire current and future generations of artists to pursue their dreams; and

WHEREAS, in recognition of his lifetime of achievements, the "Haligi Laureate" Award acknowledges Mr. Diola's decades of dedication, creativity, and leadership, which have laid the foundation for the continued growth and development

- of the performing arts on Guam, at the 2024 Saint Cecilia Music Gala, presented by the
