## BE IT RESOLVED BY COMMITTEE ON RULES OF *I MINA'TRENTAI*SIETTE NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:

WHEREAS, H.E. Lai Ching-te, also known as William Lai, assumed office as the 8th President of the Republic of China (Taiwan) in May 2024, marking a significant milestone in his distinguished career of public service; and

WHEREAS, Guam and Taipei have shared a sister city relationship for over fifty (50) years, established in 1973, fostering cultural and educational exchanges while promoting investment and economic opportunities in collaboration with the Taipei Economic and Cultural Office in Guam (TECO); and

**WHEREAS**, the visit of the President of Taiwan to Guam is a significant moment for fostering stronger ties between Guam and Taiwan economies, highlighting opportunities to increase tourism and cultural exchange; and

WHEREAS, Taiwan's contributions to Guam's economic growth are evident in its investments across various sectors, including tourism, banking, insurance, construction, real estate, and power generation, all of which have significantly boosted

Guam's economy over the past years; and

WHEREAS, the Taipei Economic and Cultural Office (TECO) in Guam, representing the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Republic of China (Taiwan), has played a pivotal role in promoting meaningful partnerships, facilitating cultural and educational exchanges, and advancing trade and economic collaboration; and WHEREAS, the educational exchanges between Guam and Taiwan have provided opportunities for high school and college students from Guam to study in Taiwan, while medical professionals from Taiwan have supported Guam's healthcare system by sharing expertise and aiding local doctors and nurses in delivering patient care; and WHEREAS, the quality of care provided by Taiwan's medical professionals has 

WHEREAS, the quality of care provided by Taiwan's medical professionals has led many Guam residents to seek treatment there, highlighted by the January 2020 Memorandum of Understanding making Taipei Adventist Hospital a referral hospital for Guam Memorial Hospital patients further enhancing the well-being of Guam's residents; and

**WHEREAS,** during the COVID-19 pandemic, Taiwan extended vital support to Guam by providing essential medical supplies, including personal protective equipment (PPE), to strengthen the island's healthcare response; and

WHEREAS, Guam's tourism industry welcomed approximately three thousand (3,000) visitors from Taiwan annually pre-pandemic and Guam's tourism recovery efforts to attract more Taiwanese visitors are supported by the recent launch of direct flights; and

WHEREAS, Guam continues to welcome global leaders and President Lai Ching-te's visit to Guam provides an opportunity to celebrate shared achievements and explore avenues for deeper connections in areas such as culture, education, commerce, tourism, and public health; now therefore, be it
