AN ACT TO *ADD* A NEW § 79607 TO ARTICLE 6 OF CHAPTER 79, TITLE 21, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO AUTHORIZING THE INDEPENDENT VIETNAM VETERANS ASSOCIATION OF GUAM TO USE A PORTION OF THE SKINNER PLAZA TO ESTABLISH THE VIETNAM VETERANS MEMORIAL MONUMENT HONORING THE SEVENTY-SEVEN (77) SONS OF GUAM WHO MADE THE ULTIMATE SACRIFICE, AND ALL OF THE VIETNAM VETERANS IN SERVICE OF OUR ISLAND AND COUNTRY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent. *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* finds that the nonprofit organization Independent Vietnam Veterans Association of Guam wishes to utilize a portion of the Skinner Plaza to establish a memorial monument honoring the seventy-seven (77) sons of Guam who made the ultimate sacrifice, and all of the Vietnam Veterans in service of our island and country.

I Liheslaturan Guåhan further finds that the Skinner Plaza, located within the Guam Capitol District, is home to several monuments honoring past conflicts that involved the sons and daughters of Guam.

Therefore, it is the intent of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* to grant the nonprofit organization Independent Vietnam Veterans Association of Guam with the authority to establish the Vietnam Veterans Memorial Monument within the Skinner Plaza in honor of the seventy-seven (77) sons of Guam who made the ultimate sacrifice, and all of the Vietnam Veterans in service of our island and country.

Section 2. A new § 79607 is hereby *added* to Article 6 of Chapter 79, Title 21, Guam Code Annotated, to read as follows:

"§ 79607. Vietnam Veterans Memorial Monument.

The Independent Vietnam Veterans Association of Guam is hereby authorized to erect, on Lot 5 and Lot 6 of the Skinner Plaza in the municipality of $Hag\mathring{a}t\~{n}a$, the Vietnam Veterans Memorial Monument in honor of the seventy-seven (77) men who paid the ultimate sacrifice in service to Guam and the United States during the Vietnam War; provided, that the Vietnam Veterans Memorial Monument does not occupy more than twenty feet (20') in length and twenty feet (20') in width of the Skinner Plaza; submits to I Liheslaturan Guåhan the plan and design of the monument for legislative approval by statute or resolution; and does not hold the Government of Guam liable or responsible for any expenses related to the construction of the monument authorized herein."

- Section 3. Severability. If any provision of this Act or its application to any person or circumstance is found to be invalid or inorganic, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of this Act that can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this Act are severable.
- **Section 4. Effective Date.** This Act shall be effective upon enactment.
