AN ACT TO ADD A NEW §3134 OF ARTICLE 1, CHAPTER 3, TITLE 17, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED RELATIVE TO TEMPORARY EMPLOYMENT OF GUAM DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION RETIRED FACILITIES AND MAINTENANCE PERSONNEL.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM.

Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent.

I Liheslaturan Guåhan finds that the Guam Department of Education lacks facilities and maintenance personnel, which resulted in delipidated and unsafe school environment for Guam's public-school students. During the multiple oversight and public hearings relative to the Guam Department of Education and the March 2023 Emergency Session of the Guam Legislature, Acting Superintendent Judith T. Won Pat stated that GDOE needs facilities and maintenance personnel to repair and maintain facilities and buildings of the institution.

Therefore, it is the intent of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* to temporarily hire retired Facilities and Maintenance personnel to provide safe, healthy, and clean school buildings and facilities and to comply with the Every Child is Entitled to an Adequate Public Education Act.

Section 2. A new §3134 of Article 1, Chapter 3, Title 1, Guam Code Annotated is hereby added to read:

"§3134. Temporary Employment of Retired Facilities and Maintenance Personnel.

(a) Guam Department of Education (GDOE) may hire retired GDOE facilities and maintenance personnel to support their Facilities and Maintenance Division including but not limited to auto mechanic, building maintenance supervisor, carpenter, clerk typist, electrician, equipment operator, facilities and maintenance manager, maintenance supervisor, painter, plumber, plumber leader, plumber supervisor, program coordinator, refrigerator mechanic, safety administrator, storekeeper, trades helper, warehouse supervisor, and welder; who are not eligible for Medicare Parts A & B, and who shall remain covered under the Government of Guam Group Health Insurance Program as a retired person, if a critical needs arises as a result of military activation of GDOE maintenance employees or absence due to a long-term disability status which has been certified by a medical doctor. The GDOE may exercise this hiring authority provided its authorized budget for personnel is not exceeded. The retiree hired shall fill such a vacant position and shall be terminated when the incumbent returns from military service or absence. Retirees shall be hired at a minimum of Step 1 for the position in question and shall not receive sick and annual leave. Notwithstanding § 8121(a) of Article 1, Chapter 8, Title 4 GCA, retirees hired temporarily pursuant to this Section may continue to receive retirement benefits. The Superintendent of GDOE shall submit a report to I Liheslaturan Guåhan every July 1 of the year, and again thirty (30) days after the

end of the fiscal year, of the number of retired employees hired
pursuant to this Section, the positions filled, the length of
employment, the cost of said hiring, and the nature of the critical need
that was filled.

(1) A Certificate of Necessity shall be signed by the Superintendent and posted onto the GDOE Website; confirming that the employment of a retired facilities and maintenance personnel temporarily, is necessary to fill a vacant position in order to comply with the Every Child is Entitled to an adequate Public Education Act.

Section 2. § 8121(a)(1) of Chapter 8, Title 4 Guam Code Annotated is *amended* to read as follows:

"(a) (1) A retired member who subsequently becomes an employee eligible for membership under § 8106 of this Title prior to January 1, 1999, shall, upon becoming so employed, have that member's right to receive payment of that member's annuity suspended for the duration of that member's employment, but all other rights pertaining to that member's annuity provided by this Article, including automatic increases therein, shall be retained by that member. The provisions of this Section shall not be applicable to any retired Judge or Justice designated and assigned by the Chief Justice to perform judicial duties in the courts of Guam as provided for in § 6115 of Title 7 GCA, or any person employed by the Department of Education in Guam schools, as a substitute teacher, maintenance, construction, plumbing, electrical, mechanical or related trades and vocations, inclusive of trades helpers and assistants; or as a Certified Augmentation Teaching

Service (CATS) employee as that term is defined by Title 17 GCA § 3127(b), regardless of which government agency the employee retired from. Such employment shall be subject to the provisions of Subsection (d) of this Section. Notwithstanding the provisions of 4 GCA, the Guam Education Board shall determine, by board policy, the terms and conditions for the re-employment of Government of Guam retirees to include whether the employee is paid over nine (9) or twelve (12) months or on a part-time basis and must comply with all Equal Employment Opportunity laws and the United States and Guam Labor laws."

Section 2. Effective Date. This Act shall be effective immediately.

Section 3. Severability. *If* any provision of this Act or its application to any person or circumstances is found to be invalid or contrary to law, such invalidity *shall not* affect other provisions or applications of this Act which can be given effect without the invalid provisions or application, and to this end the provisions of this Act are severable.
