AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE THE SUM OF TWO MILLION DOLLARS (\$2,000,000) FROM THE RAINY DAY FUND TO FARMERS FOR CROP DAMAGES PROGRAM ESTABLISHED PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 64A, TITLE 5 OF THE GUAM CODE ANNOTATED.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Appropriation to the Department of Agriculture.

Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the sum of two million dollars
(\$2,000,000) is appropriated from the Rainy Day Fund to the Guam Department of
Agriculture for the sole purpose of funding the Crop Loss Compensation Program
(CLCP).

Section 2. Administration.

8 Funds appropriated by Section 1 of this Act are not subject to any transfer 9 authority. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, rule, or regulation, the 10 Director of the Guam Department of Agriculture shall provide reports to the Guam 11 Legislature on a monthly basis until all the funds are expended.

12 Section 3. Transfer of Authority Prohibited.

1	The funds in this Act <i>shall</i> continue to be available until expended and <i>shall</i>
2	not be subject to any transfer of authority of I Maga'Hagan Guahan or any inter-
3	fund borrowing for us for any other purpose.
4	Section 4. Severability.
5	If any provision of this Act or its application to any person or circumstance is
6	held invalid, the invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of this
7	Act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application and to this
8	end the provisions of this Act are severable.
9	Section 5. Enactment.

10 This Act shall be effective upon enactment.
