AN ACT TO *AMEND* § 90.308 OF ARTICLE 7, CHAPTER 90, TITLE 9, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO INCREASING THE PLEDGE OR RESERVATION OF REVENUES OF "THE DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS MODERNIZATION ACT OF 2021."

1 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:** Section 1. § 90.308 of Article 7, Chapter 90, Title 9, Guam Code Annotated, 2 3 is hereby *amended* to read as follows: "§ 90.308. Pledge or Reservation of Revenues. 4 Rental payments under the lease and the lease-back may 5 (a) be secured by a pledge or other reservation of revenues collected by the 6 7 government of Guam from the following: 8 The sum of no more than Five Million Dollars (1)(\$5,000,000) from the revenues received pursuant to 11 GCA 9 10 Chapter 42, Earned Income Tax Credit will be available for 11 Fiscal Year 2022 only.

(2) The sum of no more than Fifteen Million Dollars(\$15,000,000) from the General Fund shall be appropriated annually thereafter.

(3) The Governor of Guam may use federal funds that are made available to the government of Guam by the United States federal government for the financing, design, construction, and maintenance of the new Department of Corrections facility.

- 9 (4) The use of other financing options is authorized for 10 the purpose of this Act, including, but not limited to, loans, 11 grants, bond financing, and other alternate funding options, 12 subject to legislative approval.
- 13 Any amounts reserved or pledged as provided in this (b)14 Section shall be subject to annual appropriations for the purpose of 15 making lease-back payments. The revenues pledged or reserved and thereafter received by the government of Guam or by any trustee, 16 depository, or custodian shall be deposited in a separate account and 17 shall be immediately subject to such reservation or the lien of such 18 19 pledge without any physical delivery thereof or further action, and such 20 reservation or the lien of such pledge shall be valid and binding against 21 all parties having claims of any kind in tort, contract or otherwise against the government of Guam or such trustee, depository or 22 23 custodian, irrespective of whether the parties have notice thereof. The instrument by which such pledge or reservation is created need be 24 25 recorded."
- 26 Section 2. Effective Date. This Act shall be effective upon enactment.
- 27 Section 3. Severability. If any provision of this Act or its application to any

person or circumstance is found to be invalid or inorganic, such invalidity shall not
affect other provisions or applications of this Act that can be given effect without
the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this Act are
severable.
