AN ACT TO AMEND §8107 TITLE 17 OF THE GÜAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO REQUIRING SUFFICIENT CLASSROOMS FOR *CHAMORRO* LANGUAGE AND CULTURE COURSES IN EVERY PUBLIC SCHOOL.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

## Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent

I Liheslaturan Guåhan finds that the teaching of Chamorro Language 3 and Culture requires specialized expertise, as the instructional content is in 4 and of itself unique in nature. As means to enhance and cultivate the practice 5 of the *Chamorro* language and culture, instructors must incorporate all 6 7 elements of teaching through visual aids, hands-on experience, conversational repetition and practice and to do so successfully will require a 8 classroom used specifically and exclusively for such purpose. This will 9 allow students to be fully immersed in the practice of the Chamorro 10 language and culture. Additionally, hands-on experience of the *Chamorro* 11 12 culture includes but is not limited to, cooking, weaving, carving, and cultural dance. 13

Therefore, it is the intent of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* to continue to preserve, perpetuate, and promote the *Chamorro* culture through the teaching of the *Chamorro* language and Culture to our students. Furthermore, *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* finds that the provisioning of dedicated space for the expressed purpose as stated herein, raises the level of importance of cultural preservation and enables instruction to occur in a quality learning environment that is not ad hoc.

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**Section 2.** §8107 of Chapter 8 of Title 17 of the Guam Code Annotated is hereby *amended* to read:

Chamorro Language and Culture Classroom(s) **(1) %8107. Required.** The Board shall require that every existing or new public school where new classrooms are constructed must provide sufficient classroom(s) for the exclusive purpose of *Chamorro* Language and Culture instruction. For all other existing public schools, the Board shall immediately implement a study to determine the most feasible methods to provide sufficient classroom(s) for the exclusive purpose of *Chamorro* Language and Culture instruction, dedicate a permanent classroom used exclusively for Chamorro studies to ensure the permanency and quality of instructional delivery of Chamorro Language and Culture, by providing one (1) classroom per *Chamorro* Language teacher designated for such use per elementary and secondary school.
