AN ACT TO AMEND §8113, CHAPTER 8 OF TITLE 5 GUAM CODE ANNOTATED RELATIVE TO THE MINUTES OF EVERY MEETING OF EACH PUBLIC AGENCY BEING POSTED ON THE PUBLIC AGENCY'S WEBSITE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:.

Section 1. §8113 of Chapter 8 of Title 5 GCA is hereby *amended* to read:

"§8113. Minutes. The minutes of every meeting of each public agency shall be promptly and fairly recorded, shall be open to public inspection and shall include but not be limited to a record of all motions, proposals and resolutions offered, the results of any votes taken and a record of individual votes in event of roll call. Insofar as it may do so without violating § 8103 of this Chapter, an agency may also maintain a record of persons present at a meeting. Beginning July 1, 2011, each public agency shall post the minutes on its website within ten (10) days after the approval of the minutes by the public agency. The Legislature shall post all audio or video recordings of legislative public hearings, the committee of the whole and legislative sessions within four (4) days. Beginning July 1, 2011, the minutes of

- 1 meetings open to the public posted on the public agency's website shall remain
- 2 posted on the website for at least ninety (90) days after their initial posting. All audio
- or video recordings of legislative public hearings, the committee of the whole and
- 4 legislative sessions shall be posted by on the Legislature's website shall remain
- 5 posted on the website for at least one (1) year after their initial posting.
