AN ACT TO ADD A NEW SUBSECTION (i) TO §75108 AND TO ADD A NEW SECTION 75121 TO CHAPTER 75, TITLE 21 GUAM CODE ANNOTATED RELATIVE TO LEASES AND LICENSES FOR CHAMORRO LAND TRUST COMMISSION PROPERTIES AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. Legislative Intent. The Guam Legislature finds that it 1 2 must act to preserve the integrity of Chamorro Land Trust lands for future generations. As such, the lands must not be used or abused in its 3

development which will render such land inhabitable or unsuitable for use

by the Trust's benefciaries for the production of food sources or the use as

shelter and homes. 6

Section 2. Subsection (i) is hereby added to §75108, Chapter 75,

Title 21 Guam Code Annotated to read as follows:

"\$75108. Conditions in Leases. 12

(i). The Commission shall not approve any lease or license for any 13

activity or development on any Chamorro Land Trust property that will not

allow the use of such property for agriculture or residential development 15

upon the expiration or termination of such lease or license. Any such license or lease where such use is authorized shall be declared null and void.

Section 3. A new Section 75121 is hereby added to Chapter 75, Title 21 Guam Code Annotated to read as follows:

No Department or Agency of the government of Guam with any regulatory or permitting authority for any development where a permit or regulatory permission is required thereof may issue such permit or act on regulatory authority for any permit required for any Chamorro Land Trust property licensed or leased to person(s) and/or organizations(s) that will not allow the use of such property for agriculture or residential development upon the expiration or termination of such lease or license.

Section 4. Severability. If any of the provisions of this Act or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect any other provision or application of this Act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this Act are severable.
