AN ACT TO AMEND §22425(q) OF ARTICLE 4, CHAPTER 22, DIVISION 2, TITLE 5, GUAM CODE RELATIVE ANNOTATED, TO DESIGNATING ADDITIONAL REVENUE DERIVED FROM THE VALUATION OF REAL PROPERTY, DUE TO **COMMENCE DURING CALENDAR YEARS 2013 AND** 2014. TOWARDS THE **REPLACEMENT**, OR RENOVATION OF, SIMON SANCHEZ HIGH SCHOOL, AND OTHER EDUCATION FACILITIES REOUIRING NEW CONSTRUCTION OR **REHABILITATION; AND FOR OTHER EDUCATION-RELATED PURPOSES.**

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent. I Liheslaturan Guåhan
finds that the Department of Revenue and Taxation recently informed I
Liheslatura's Committee on Aviation, Ground Transportation, Regulatory
Concerns, and Future Generations, during an Oversight Hearing held in
early March 2013, that the process of completing a valuation of real

property is scheduled to commence with the issuance of a Request for
 Proposal for applicable services.

3 I Liheslatura finds that the valuation of real property, which is scheduled to occur during calendar years 2013 and 2014, is expected to 4 5 yield an upward adjustment of real property payments. Therefore, *I* Liheslaturan Guåhan intends for the additional proceeds collected, as a result 6 of the anticipated real property valuation, to be appropriated from the 7 8 Territorial Education Facilities Fund for the purpose of funding educationrelated priorities, including the replacement, or renovation of, Simon 9 10 Sanchez High School, and other education facilities requiring new 11 construction or rehabilitation; and, for other education purposes, including 12 the purchase of new school buses.

I Liheslatura further intends to authorize *I Maga'låhen Guåhan* to pledge the additional proceeds as a source of payment for a General Obligation bond, or municipal lease financing, secured for the purposes stated herein.

Estimated Revenue Report Required. No later than 17 Section 2. 18 thirty (30) days following the completion and approval of the valuation of 19 real property, the Director of Revenue and Taxation shall provide a written 20 estimate of the additional revenue that would accrue to the government of Guam as a result of the most recent valuation of real property. 21 The 22 estimate shall be transmitted immediately upon completion to I 23 Liheslaturan Guåhan.

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1	Section 3. Funding Authorized. §22425(q) of Article 4, Chapter 22,
2	Division 2, Title 5, Guam Code Annotated, is hereby amended, to read:

6	education-related purposes. In the event that the debt capacity of the
7	government of Guam as limited under §11 of the Organic Act of Guam
8	shall, as a result of the triennial property tax valuation now underway, be
9	increased by no less that \$101,000,000 the aggregate principal amount of
10	bonds authorized under this section shall be increased by \$101,000,000 and
11	the following project shall be added to the projects listed in subsection (m)

 Guam Economic Development Authority may pursue municipal lease
 financing.

<u>The balance of the revenue referenced herein shall remain available</u>
<u>to fund projects authorized in accordance with §22425(m) of Article 4,</u>
<u>Division 2, Chapter 22, Title 5, Guam Code Annotated.</u>"

8 Section 4. Severability. If any provision of this Act or its 9 application to any person or circumstance is found to be invalid or contrary 10 to law, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of 11 this Act which can be given effect without the invalid provisions or 12 application, and to this end the provisions of this Act are severable.

13 Section 5. Effective Date. This Act shall be effective upon
14 enactment.
