AN ACT TO ADD SUBSECTION (d) TO §3102.3 CHAPTER 3 OF 17 GUAM CODE ANNOTATED RELATIVE TO THE COMPOSITION OF THE GUAM EDUCATION BOARD TO INCLUDE A REPRESENTATIVE FROM THE MAYORS' COUNCIL OF GUAM.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

SECTION 1. Legislative Findings and intent. I Liheslaturan Guåhan finds

2 the Mayors on Guam are a part of the intricacies of policy making within our

community and play a vital role as members of numerous boards and commissions on

Guam.

5 I Liheslaturan Guåhan further finds that a Mayor representative of the Mayors'

6 Council of Guam (MCOG) was at one time an appointed ex-officio member of the

Guam Education Policy Board (GEPB) pursuant to Public Law 26-26. Public Law 31-

8 19 amended portions of Chapter 3 of Title 17 of the Guam Code Annotated, which

removed the section of the law that included a non-voting ex-officio member to be part

of the GEPB.

I Liheslaturan Guåhan further finds the Mayor representative to the GEPB have

proven to be a contributing member to the GEPB to promote community involvement

and support of our education school system and the children they serve.

Therefore, *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* intends to amend the composition of the GEPB to include a Mayor representative of the MCOG.

SECTION 2. Subsection (d) is hereby added to Section 3102.3, Chapter 3 of 17 Guam Code Annotated to read as follows:

"§3102.3. Composition and Terms of Office for Board Members.

- (d) Non-Voting Member of the Mayors' Council of Guam. One (1) member appointed by the Mayors' Council of Guam who shall serve for a term of two (2) years or the remaining term of the appointed mayor, whichever is longer."
- **SECTION 3. Severability**. If any of the provisions of this Act or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity *shall* not affect any other provision or application of this Act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this Act are severable.
