#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

- 2 Section 1. Removal of Slot Machines in definition of Gaming Devices.
- 3 Sub-item "(1)" of subsection "(n)" pertaining to the definition of Gaming
- 4 Device, of §7102, Chapter 7, Title 3, of the Guam Administrative Rules and
- 5 Regulations is hereby deleted, to read as follows:
- 6 "(n) "Gaming device" means any equipment or mechanical,
- 7 electromechanical or electronic contrivance, component or machine used remotely
- 8 or directly in connection with gaming or any game which affects the result of a
- 9 wager by determining win or loss. The term includes:
- 10 (1) A slot machine."
- 11 Section 2. Effective Date.
- The provisions contained herein shall be effective upon enactment of
