AN ACT TO ADD A NEW §5013 TO TITLE 5, CHAPTER 5 OF TITLE 5 GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO GOVERNMENT PROCUREMENT POLICY IN FAVOR OF WOMEN OWNED BUSINESSES.



BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

- A new §5013 is added to Chapter 5 of Title 5 Guam Code Annotated
- 3 to read as follows:

- 4 "§5013. Policy In Favor of Women Owned Businesses.
- 5 (a) Notwithstanding any provision of law, and except for the
- 6 procurement of professional services, if any entity of the government of
- 7 Guam or any entity expending governmental funds intends to procure any
- 8 supply or service, which is offered by a business concern that is at least
- 9 fifty-one percent (51%) owned by one or more women, that entity shall
- 10 procure such supply or service from that business concern, if the supply or
- service is available within the period required by the procuring entity and

- 1 the price for the supply or service does not exceed one hundred five
- 2 percent (105%) of the lowest price bidder, and shall be in addition to any
- 3 other procurement benefit the women owned business may qualify for
- 4 under Guam law.
- 5 (b) A business concern is qualified under this section if:
- 6 (1) the business concern is licensed to do business on Guam;
- 7 (2) the business concern maintains its headquarters on Guam;
- 8 (3) the business concern is at least fifty-one percent (51%) by one
- 9 or more women; and
- 10 (4) one or more women of the business concern has filed
- individual tax returns on Guam for a period of at least three (3) consecutive
- 12 years."
