THE AN ACT TO PRIORITIZE THE **FUNDING OF** CLASSIFIED AND UNCLASSIFIED EMPLOYEES OF THE GOVERNMENT OF GUAM BY SETTING THE SALARIES OF I MAGA'LÅHEN GUÅHAN, I SEGUNDU NA MAGA'LÅHEN GUÅHAN, SENATORS OF I LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN, THE ATTORNEY GENERAL OF GUAM, THE PUBLIC AUDITOR OF GUAM, AND HEADS OF THE DEPARTMENTS AND AGENCIES OF THE EXECUTIVE BRANCH TO OCTOBER 1, 2013 SALARY RATES.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, rule, regulation,

3 policy, or procedure, the salaries of I Maga'låhen Guåhan, I Segundu na

4 Maga'låhen Guåhan, Senators of I Liheslaturan Guåhan, the Attorney General of

5 Guam, and the Public Auditor of Guam, *shall* be set to their respective salary rates

6 that were effective on October 1, 2013. No appropriation or authorization from

7 Fiscal Years 2014 and prior shall be authorized for the payment of salaries to the

positions identified in this Section at a salary rate above the salary rates that were

effective on October 1, 2013.

Section 2. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, rule, regulation,

policy, or procedure, the salaries of all employees on the attached Exhibit A which

shall include, but not be limited to, I Maga'låhen Guåhan's appointed cabinet

members shall be set to their respective salary rates that were effective on October

- 1 1, 2013. No appropriation or authorization from Fiscal Years 2014 and prior, shall
- 2 be authorized for the payment of salaries to the positions in the Executive Pay Plan
- 3 in this Section at a salary rate above the salary rates that were effective on October
- 4 1, 2013.
- 5 Section 3. Section 1106(a), Title 2 of the Guam Code Annotated to read:
- 6 "(a) Compensation of each member of I Liheslaturan Guåhan [the Guam
- 7 Legislature] shall be paid in twenty-six (26) equal installments at the rate per
- 8 annum of fifty percent (50%) of the annual salary of a judge of the Superior
- 9 Court; the compensation of the Speaker of I Liheslaturan Guåhan shall be paid in
- 10 twenty six (26) equal installments at the rate of fifty percent (50%) of the annual
- 11 salary of the presiding judge of the Superior Court. Sixty Thousand Eight
- Hundred Forty Dollars (\$60,840.00); the compensation of the Speaker of I
- 13 Liheslaturan Guåhan shall be paid in twenty-six (26) equal installments at the
- rate per annum of Sixty Seven Thousand Six Hundred Dollars (\$67,600.00).
- 15 Such compensation *shall* be paid out of funds to be appropriated to *I Liheslaturan*
- 16 Guåhan [the Guam Legislature]."
- 17 Section 4. Effective Date. This Act *shall* be effective immediately upon
- 18 enactment.
- 19 Section 5. Severability. If any provision of this Act or its application to
- 20 any person or circumstance is found to be invalid or contrary to law, such
- 21 invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of this Act which can be
- 22 given effect without the invalid provisions or application, and to this end the
- 23 provisions of this Act are severable.
