AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 3, SECTION 4, AND TO REPEAL SECTION 6 ALL OF PUBLIC LAW 21-130 TO AUTHORIZE DEPARTMENT OF LAND MANAGEMENT TO EXCHANGE PRIVATE PROPERTY TAKEN FOR THE CONSTUCTION OF THE AGAT – UMATAC HIGHWAY WITH GOVERNMENT LAND.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 3 of Public Law 21-130 is hereby amended to read as

3 follows:

"Legislative findings and intent. The Legislature has been apprised by the 4 Department of Land Management (DLM) and the Department of Public Works 5 (DPW that the continuation of the work on Route 2, the Agat-Umatac Highway, is 6 7 totally dependent on the acquisition of certain parcels of private property. The Legislature finds that such widening and reconstruction of the Agat-Umatac 8 Highway must continue, and thus it is clear those private properties which have not 9 been condemned for such purposes must be utilized. With this in mind, it is the 10 11 intent of the Legislature that the owners of such properties either be justly compensated or be afforded the opportunity to exchange the lands required for the 12 reconstruction and widening with government properties on a value-for-value 13 basis. 14

It has been over twenty-one (21) years since the enactment of this Act to 1 exchange government parcels with private property in order for the DPW to 2 complete the work to widen Route 2. Unfortunately, as of this date there are some 3 private landowners who were never compensated or afforded the opportunity to 4 exchange lands pursuant to law. 5 Over the years, the DPW has made a determination that the government land 6 identified in this Act is unsuitable for development and therefore the DLM has 7

identified new parcels of government land for exchange. 8 9 I Liheslatura Guåhan further finds that the DLM worked diligently with the

private landowners and the Mayor of Umatac, to identify parcels of government 10 land acceptable for the exchange. 11

Therefore, *I Liheslatura Guåhan* intends to right the wrong that was done to 12 these private landowners for over twenty-one (21) years and authorize the DLM to 13 exchange government parcels with the private landowners." 14

Section 2. Section 4 in Public Law 21-130 is hereby amended to read as 15 follows: 16

"Section 4. Land exchanges authorized. (a) Notwithstanding any other 17 provision of law, the Governor of Guam is authorized to exchange government 18 property, on a value-for-value basis, with the following owners for their respective 19 parcels situated along the proposed route for Route 2, the Agat- Umatac Highway: 20

14 The lottery shall be administered jointly by the Department of Land

15 Management and the Mayor of Umatac.

16 Section 3. Section 6 of Public Law 21-130 is hereby repealed in its entirety.

17 "Section 6. No further legislation required. Aware of the importance of this
18 Act toward the most expeditious and economical completion of the Agat Umatac
19 Highway, the passage of this Act and its enactment into law shall be deemed
20 approval by the Legislature of the exchanges and no further legislative action shall
21 be required."

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Section 4. Effective Date. This Act *shall* become effective upon enactment.

Section 5. Severability. If any provision of this Law or its application to any person or circumstances is found to be invalid or contrary to law, such invalidity *shall not* affect other provisions or applications of this Law which can be given effect without the invalid provisions or application and to this end the provisions of this Act are severable.

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
