AN ACT TO ADD A NEW SUBSECTION (c) TO §3102 OF  
CHAPTER 3, TITLE 3, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED; AND  
NEW §3101.3 TO §3101 OF CHAPTER 3, TITLE 16, GUAM  
CODE ANNOTATED RELATIVE TO VOTER PRE-  
REGISTRATION OF PERSONS AT LEAST SIXTEEN (16)  
YEARS OF AGE.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. A *new* subsection (c) is hereby *added* to §3102 of Chapter 3,  
3 Title 3 of Guam Code Annotated to read:

4 “(c) Notwithstanding subsection (a) of this section,  
5 upon satisfactory proof of age, every person that meets all  
6 eligibility requirements to register and is sixteen (16) years of age  
7 or older but will not have reached eighteen (18) years of age by the  
8 date of the next election may preregister to vote. A properly  
9 executed registration made pursuant to this subdivision shall be  
10 deemed effective as of the date the affiant will be eighteen (18)  
11 years of age, if the information in the affidavit of registration is

1 still current at the time. If the information provided by the affiant  
2 is not current at the time that the registration would otherwise  
3 become effective, the affiant must provide current information by  
4 any means authorized in this chapter for persons eighteen (18)  
5 years of age or older for the affiant's registration to become  
6 effective.

7 **Section 2. A new §3101.3 is hereby added to §3101 of Chapter 3, Title**  
8 **16 of Guam Code Annotated to read:**

9 **“3101.3. License: Voter Pre-Registration.**

10 (a) Applicants between the ages of sixteen (16) and eighteen (18)  
11 may pre-register to vote with the Guam Election Commission  
12 in compliance with §3102 of Chapter 3, Title 3 GCA, when  
13 applying for a Guam motor vehicle driver's license pursuant to  
14 §3101 of this Title.

15 (b) Every qualified applicant identified in the Section may  
16 authorize the Guam Motor Vehicle Administrator to:

17 (1) Collect the necessary personal information required for  
18 voter pre-registering the applicant with the Guam  
19 Election Commission and transmit the necessary personal  
20 information;

21 (2) Transmit said information to the Guam Election  
22 Commission pursuant to provisions in this Section for

1                    purposes of pre-registering the applicant with the Guam  
2                    Election Commission; and

3                    (3) Collect, on a form determined by the Guam Motor  
4                    Vehicle Administrator, from each applicant, his or her  
5                    affirmation that he or she is consenting to voter pre-  
6                    registration with the Guam Election Commission,  
7                    pursuant to §3102 of Chapter 3, Title 3 GCA.

8                    (c) The Guam Motor Vehicle Administrator shall establish a  
9                    procedure to collect from the application of a consenting  
10                    qualified applicant between sixteen (16) and eighteen (18) years  
11                    of age the necessary personal information required for voter  
12                    pre-registration of the applicant with the Guam Election  
13                    Commission and transmit the necessary personal information  
14                    of the applicant to the Guam Election Commission for purposes  
15                    of pre-registering the applicant, pursuant to §3102 of Chapter 3,  
16                    Title 3 GCA.

17                    (d) The provisions of the Title shall apply to all consenting  
18                    qualified applicants between sixteen (16) and eighteen (18)  
19                    years of age applying for issuance, renewal, or duplicate of a  
20                    Guam motor vehicle driver's license.

1 (e) Refusal by the applicant to pre-register with the Guam Election  
2 Commission shall not be a basis for denial of a Guam motor  
3 vehicle driver's license."

4 **Section 3. Effective Date.** This Act shall become immediately effective  
5 upon enactment.

6 **Section 4. Severability.** If any of the provisions of this Act or the  
7 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such  
8 invalidity shall *not* affect any other provision or application of this Act which  
9 can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this  
10 end the provisions of this Act are severable.
