AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE TRANSFER OF THE SUM OF FIVE HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$500,000) FROM FISCAL YEAR 2015 APPROPRIATIONS TO COMPLY WITH THE UNITED STATES DISTRICT COURT OF GUAM ORDER DATED JANUARY 16, 2015 IN CIVIL CASE NO. 91-00020; AND TO REQUIRE THE DIRECTOR OF THE DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS TO REPORT TO THE SPEAKER OF LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN ON MATTERS RELATIVE TO CIVIL CASE NO. 91-00020.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. Transfer Authority. I Maga'lahen Guåhan is hereby authorized to transfer not more than the sum of Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$500,000) in General Fund appropriations from Sections 1(a) through 1(ff), Chapter V of Public Law 32-181, with the exception of the General Fund appropriations to the Guam Police Department, the Guam Fire Department, and the Department of Corrections, to the appropriate department and/or agency for the sole purpose of complying with the United States District Court of Guam Order dated January 16, 2015 in Civil Case No. 91-00020. No appropriation that is transferred in this Section shall be used for the expenditure of private legal counsel for the government of Guam. The Director of the Bureau of Budget and

Management Research shall provide a notice of each transfer authorized by this Section, to include the department and/or agency from which appropriations were transferred, and department and/or agency to which such appropriations were transferred; and justification, therefore, is provided in a written report to the Speaker of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan no later than* five (5) days after such transfer is authorized and/or made.

Section 2. Reporting Requirements. The Director of the Department of Corrections shall provide a written report to the Speaker of I Liheslaturan Guåhan no later than twenty (20) days after the end of each month on all matters agreed upon in the United States District Court September 26, 2014 Status Report in Civil Case No. 91-00020, and matters addressed in the United States District Court Order dated January 16, 2015 in Civil Case No. 91-00020. The Director of the Department of Corrections shall also provide to the Speaker of I Liheslaturan Guåhan a copy of the weekly reports regarding clinical operations at the Department that are provided to the Monitor of Civil Case No. 91-00020, no later than five (5) days after such report is provided to said Monitor.

Section 3. Effective Date. This Act shall become effective upon enactment.

Section 4. Severability. If any provision of this Act or its application to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of this Act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application and to this end the provisions of this Act are severable.

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AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE TRANSFER OF THE SUM OF FIVE HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$500,000) FROM FISCAL YEAR 2015 APPROPRIATIONS TO COMPLY WITH THE UNITED STATES DISTRICT COURT OF GUAM ORDER DATED JANUARY 16, 2015 IN CIVIL CASE NO. 91-00020.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

2 **Transfer Authority.** I Maga'låhen Guåhan is hereby Section 1. 3 authorized to transfer not more than the sum of Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$500,000) in General Fund appropriations from Sections 1(a) through 1(ff), 4 Chapter V of Public Law 32-181 with the exception of General Fund 5 6 appropriations to the Guam Police Department, Guam Fire Department, and the 7 Department of Corrections, to the appropriate department and/or agency for the 8 sole purpose of complying with the United States District Court of Guam Order dated January 16, 2015 in Civil Case No. 91-00020. No appropriation that is 9 transferred in this Section shall be used for the expenditure of private legal counsel 10 11 for the government of Guam. The Director of the Bureau of Budget and Management Research shall provide a notice of each transfer, authorized by this 12 13 Section, including the department and/or agency from which and department 14 and/or agency to which such appropriations were transferred and justification 15 therefore is provided in a written report to the Speaker of I Liheslaturan Guåhan 16 not later than five (5) days after such transfer is authorized and/or made.

Section 2. Reporting Requirements. The Director of the Department of 1 2 Corrections shall provide a written report to the Speaker of I Liheslaturan Guåhan 3 not later than twenty (20) days after the end of each month on all matters agreed upon in the United States District Court September 26, 2014 Status Report in Civil 4 5 Case No. 91-00020 and matters addressed in the United States District Court Order 6 dated January 16, 2015 in Civil Case No. 91-00020. The Director of the Department of Corrections shall provide a copy of the weekly reports regarding 7 8 clinical operations at the department that are provided to the Monitor of Civil Case 9 No. 91-00020, to the Speaker of I Liheslaturan Guåhan not later than five (5) days 10 after such report is provided to said Monitor.

11 Section 3. Enactment. This Act shall become effective upon enactment.

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**Section 4. Severability.** *If* any provision of this Act or its application to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the invalidity *shall not* affect other provisions or applications of this Act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application and to this end the provisions of this Act are severable.
