AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 6 OF CHAPTER XI OF PUBLIC LAW 33-66; RELATIVE TO PROVIDING INCENTIVE REWARDS FOR RETIREES TO ENROLL IN THE GOVERNMENT OF GUAM HEALTH INSURANCE RETIREE SUPPLEMENTAL PLAN.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. Section 6 of Chapter XI of Public Law 33-66 is hereby
amended to read:

4 "Section 6. Retiree Medical, Dental and Life Insurance
5 Expenses Appropriated to the Government of Guam Retirement
6 Fund (GGRF).

7 (a) The sum of Twenty-Three Million Five Thousand Nine 8 Hundred Eighty-One Dollars (\$23,005,981) is appropriated from the 9 General Fund and One Million Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$1,200,000) is appropriated from the Section 2718 Fund to the GGRF 1011 to pay for retiree group medical and dental insurance premiums and life insurance subsidy, including retiree group medical and dental 12 13 insurance premiums and coverage and life insurance subsidy for 14 Judiciary of Guam retirees, to continue existing programs currently 15 contained in the semi-monthly payments. The appropriation from the

unappropriated fund balance of the Section 2718 Fund in this Section
 shall continue to be available until fully expended.

(b) The sum of not more than One Hundred Fifty Thousand 3 Dollars (\$150,000) shall be allocated from the appropriation in 4 Section 6(a) of this Chapter to the GGRF for the sole purpose of 5 providing incentive rewards for eligible Government of Guam retirees 6 7 who enroll in anyRetireeSupplemental Insurance Agreement offered under the Fiscal Year 2016 Government of Guam Health Insurance 8 Program. The incentive rewards may be in the form of cash orgift 9 certificate and *shall* be payable in equal amounts to each individual 10 enrollee's name in a manner and form as determined by GGRF." 11

Section 2. Enactment. This Act *shall* be effective either on October
1, 2016 or upon enactment, whichever is *later*.

14 Section 3. Severability. If any provision of this Act or its application 15 to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the invalidity *shall not* affect 16 other provisions or applications of this Act which can be given effect 17 without the invalid provision or application and to this end the provisions of 18 this Act are severable.
