

AN ACT TO ADD A *NEW* SECTION 1106.2 TO
CHAPTER 1, TITLE 2 GUAM CODE ANNOTATED
RELATIVE TO REPAYMENT OF RETROACTIVE
SENATORIAL SALARIES DISBURSED UNDER
PUBLIC LAW 32-208; AND TO *AMEND* SECTION 5
OF PUBLIC LAW 32-208 FOR SIMILAR PURPOSES

1 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2 **Section 1.** A new Section 1106.2 is *added* to Chapter 1, Title 2 of the Guam
3 Code Annotated to read:

4 "1106.2 **Senatorial Repayment of Retroactive Salary Increases**
5 **under Public Law 32-208.** Senators of *Mina Trentai Tres Na Liheslaturan*
6 *Guåhan* (33rd Guam Legislature) who received payments under Public Law 32-
7 208 for retroactive salary increases for the period January 15, 2014 to the
8 November 21, 2014 (the date of enactment of Public Law 32-208) shall
9 relinquish those retroactive payments and repay them to the Government of
10 Guam. The methods and terms of repayment shall be such as *I Liheslaturan*
11 *Guåhan* may fix by rule or by resolution."

1 **Section 2.** Section 5 of Public Law 32-208 (enacted November 21, 2014) is
2 *amended* to read as follows:

3 **“Section 5. Effective Date.** Notwithstanding any other provision of
4 law, Sections 1 and 2 of this Act *shall* be effective upon enactment. With the
5 exception of Senators of I Liheslaturan Guåhan, Salary increases resulting
6 from the implementation of this Act shall be effective on January 15, 2014.”

7 **Section 3. Effective Date.** Section 1 of this Act *shall* be effective upon
8 enactment. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, Section 2 of this Act *shall*
9 apply retroactively as of November 21, 2014.

10 **Section 4. Severability.** *If* any provision of this Law or its application to any
11 person or circumstance is found to be invalid or contrary to law, such invalidity shall
12 *not* affect other provisions or applications of this Law which can be given effect
13 without the invalid provisions or application, and to this end the provisions of this Act
14 are severable.
