AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE THE SUM OF EIGHT HUNDRED TWENTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$820,000) FROM FISCAL YEAR 2015 HOTEL OCCUPANCY TAX UNRESERVED FUND BALANCE TO THE GUAM MUSEUM FUND FOR MUSEUM OPERATIONAL CASH FLOW.



BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. Intent and Findings. I Liheslaturan Guahan finds that there 2 3 exists approximately Two Million Three Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$2,300,000) in the Fiscal Year 2015 Hotel Occupancy Tax Unreserved Fund Balance available 4 for appropriation. A sum of eight hundred twenty thousand dollars (\$820,000) is 5 needed to carry the operations of the Guam and Chamorro Educational Facilty 6 7 (Guam Museum) for Fiscal Year 2016. 8 I Liheslaturan Guahan further finds that the Guam Museum is a necessary component of our tourism industry. It is an important resource that will tell the four 9 10 thousand (4,000) year old story of the island of Guam and her people. The Guam 11 Museum will place Chamorro Culture front and center as Guam's unique competitive differentiator and aid the Guam Visitors Bureau in fulfilling Objective 12 Five of their Tourism 2020 plan. The Guam Museum will enhance visitor 13 14 experience as a unique cultural destination.

It is the intent of *I Liheslatura* to provide the Guam Museum with funding for FY 2016.

Section 2. Appropriation. Notwithstanding any other provisions of law, the sum of Eight Hundred Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$820,000) is appropriated from Fiscal Year 2015 Hotel Occupancy Tax Unreserved Fund Balance to the Guam Museum Fund for the purpose of providing Guam Museum operational cash flow, to thus ensure museum operations to the end of fiscal year 2016. This appropriation shall not lapse and shall remain available for the purpose identified herein until fully expended.

Section 3. Severability. If any provisions of this Act or its application thereof to any person or circumstance, is held invalid, invalidity shall not affect any other provision or application of this Act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this Act are severable.
