AN ACT TO AMEND SUBSECTION (C) OF § 77135 **OF CHAPTER** 77. TITLE 10. **GUAM** CODE ANNOTATED. **RELATIVE** TO PROVIDING DISCRETION IN THE **EXPENDITURE** PRIORITIZATION OF THE POLICE PATROL **VEHICLE AND EQUIPMENT REVOLVING FUND** TO THE CHIEF OF POLICE FOR THE PURPOSES OF ACQUIRING, REPAIRING, AND MAINTAINING VEHICLES AND REQUISITE ASSOCIATED **EQUIPMENT FOR THE GPD.**

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. Subsection (c) of § 77135 of Chapter 77, Title 10, Guam Code
Annotated is hereby *amended* to read:

4 "(c) Authorized Expenditure and Continuing Appropriation. All monies in the 5 Fund are hereby appropriated, and shall be deemed appropriated on a continuing basis 6 and shall not lapse, and shall not be subject to appropriation constraints in order to be 7 expended for the purposes of acquiring, repairing, and maintaining vehicles and 8 requisite associated equipment for the Guam Police Department. All monies in the 9 Fund shall be expended at the discretion of the Chief of Police for the purposes of acquiring, repairing, and maintaining vehicles and requisite associated equipment for 10 11 the Guam Police Department or subsidizing the utilization of privately owned vehicles for police service, patrol duty, and other law enforcement related functions, as 12

1	provided pursuant to Title 10 GCA Chapter 56. The Fund shall not be used to
2	purchase non-patrol vehicles for administrative utilization purposes.
3	(1) Thirty percent (30%) of the annual revenue collected by the Fund
4	shall be used solely for the purchase of new police patrol vehicles within the
5	government of Guam fiscal year during which the revenue was received or used
6	to subsidize the utilization of privately owned vehicles for police service, patrol
7	duty, and other law enforcement related functions, as provided pursuant to Title
8	10 GCA Chapter 56.
9	(A) The expenditure prioritization mandate pursuant to this Item
10	(1) shall not apply to the purchase of non-patrol vehicles for
11	administrative utilization purposes, which is prohibited.
12	(B) Any unexpended funds remaining at the end of the fiscal year
13	shall continue to be available for expenditure in the next fiscal year solely
14	for the purposes of this Item (1).
15	(2) Seventy percent (70%) of the annual revenue collected by the Fund
16	shall be used solely for the repair and maintenance of police patrol vehicles
17	within the government of Guam fiscal year during which such funding was
18	generated from revenue received."
19	Section 2. Severability. If any provision of this Law or its application to any
20	person or circumstance is found to be invalid or contrary to law, such invalidity shall
21	not affect other provisions or applications of this Law which can be given effect
22	without the invalid provisions or application, and to this end the provisions of this

23 Law are severable.
