	AN ACT TO <i>ADD</i> A NEW § 30.300 TO CHAPTER 30, AND A NEW § 19.81 TO CHAPTER 19, BOTH OF TITLE 9, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO THE DEFINITION AND INCLUSION OF INTERFERING WITH THE REPORTING OF FAMILY VIOLENCE IN GUAM'S ASSAULT AND FAMILY VIOLENCE STATUTES.
1	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:
2	Section 1. A new Subsection § 30.300 is <i>added</i> to Chapter 30, Title 9, Guam
3	Code Annotated to read:
4	"§ 30.300 Interfering with the Reporting of Family Violence.
5	(a) Any person commits the crime of interfering with the reporting of family
6	violence if the person:
7	(1) Commits an act of family violence, as defined in § 30.10 of this
8	Chapter; and
9	(2) Intentionally, knowingly, or recklessly prevents or attempts to
10	prevent the victim of or a witness to that act of family violence from
11	calling a 911 emergency communication system, obtaining medical
12	assistance, or making a report to any law enforcement official.
13	(b) Commission of a crime of family violence under Subsection (a) of this
14	Section is a necessary element of the crime of interfering with the reporting of
15	family violence.

1	(c) Interference with the reporting of family violence is a a felony of the
2	third degree."
3	Section 2. A new Section § 19.81 is added to Chapter 19, Title 9, Guam
4	Code Annotated, to read:
5	"§ 19.81. Interfering with the Reporting of Family Violence; Defined &
6	Punished.
7	(a) Any person commits the crime of interfering with the reporting of family
8	violence if the person:
9	(1) Commits an act of family violence, as defined in § 30.10 of
10	Chapter 30 of this Title; and
11	(2) Intentionally, knowingly, or recklessly prevents or attempts to
12	prevent the victim of or a witness to that act of family violence from
13	calling a 911 emergency communication system, obtaining medical
14	assistance, or making a report to any law enforcement official.
15	(b) Commission of a crime of family violence under Subsection (a) of this
16	Section is a necessary element of the crime of interfering with the reporting of
17	family violence.
18	(c) Interference with the reporting of family violence is a a felony of the

20	Section 3. Effective Date. This Act <i>shall</i> become effective upon enactment.
