AN ACT TO REPEAL AND REENACT § 3105 OF ARTICLE 1, CHAPTER 3, TITLE 22, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO RAISING THE MINIMUM WAGE SUBJECT TO AN INDEPENDENT STUDY AND DETERMINATION THAT A WAGE RAISE CAN BE ACCOMPLISHED RESPONSIBLY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

- 2 Section 1. § 3105 of Article 1, Chapter 3, Title 22, Guam Code Annotated,
- 3 is hereby repealed and reenacted to read:

4 "§ 3105. Minimum Wages.

- 5 Every employer shall pay each person employed by him wages at a
- 6 rate not less than Eight Dollars and Twenty-Five Cents (\$8.25) per hour, effective
- 7 January 1, 2015.

8 § 3105. Minimum Wages.

- 9 (a) Every employer *shall* pay each person employed by him wages
- at a rate not less than Nine Dollars and Twenty Cents (\$9.20) per
- hour; provided, that the Director of the Guam Department of Labor

shall have first received the completed independent report that was solicited on the economic analysis of the minimum wage increase in accordance with Public Law 32-229, and that the Director shall have determined pursuant to the independent report that: (1) most employers will not reduce hours for their employees; (2) most employers will not reduce their workforce; (3) most employers will not sacrifice scheduled wage increases to non-minimum wage, non-managerial employees; and (4) most employers will not reduce benefits for their employees.

(b) The effective date of the minimum wage set forth in Subsection
(a) of this § 3105 shall be six (6) months after the Director of the

Department of Labor receives the independent report and makes the determination required by Subsection (a)."
