1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

2 **Section 1.** § 26403 of Article 4, Title 11, Guam Code Annotated, is
3 *amended*, to read:

4 **“§ 26403. Rates.**

5 The following rates shall apply in computing, assessing and collecting
6 the liquid fuel tax:

7 (a) A tax at the rate of Ten Cents (\$0.10) per gallon on diesel fuel
8 which shall be Eleven and One Half Cents (\$0.115) per gallon on diesel fuel,
9 effective January 1, 2018; Thirteen Cents (\$0.13) per gallon on diesel fuel,
10 effective January 1, 2019; and Fourteen Cents (\$0.14) cents per gallon on
11 diesel fuel, effective January 1, 2020; and

12 (b) A tax at the rate of Eleven Cents (\$0.11) per gallon on all other
13 liquid fuel as defined herein which shall be Twelve and One Half Cents
14 (\$0.125) effective January 1, 2018; Fourteen Cents (\$0.14) effective January
15 1, 2019; and Fifteen Cents (\$0.15) effective, January 1, 2020 *except* liquid

1 fuel used for commercial aviation purposes which is taxed at a rate of Four
2 Cents (\$0.04) per gallon which shall be Five and One Half Cents (\$0.055)
3 per gallon effective January 1, 2018; Seven Cents (\$0.07) effective January
4 1, 2019; and Eight Cents (\$0.08) per gallon effective January 1, 2020.”
