AN ACT TO ADD A NEW SUBSECTION (c) to § 3101.2, CHAPTER 3, TITLE 16, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO PROVIDING AN EXEMPTION TO SPOUSES OF ACTIVE DUTY MILITARY PERSONNEL WHO ARE RESIDENTS OF GUAM FROM ANY PENALTIES UPON RENEWING THEIR GUAM DRIVER'S LICENSE UPON RETURNING TO GUAM FROM MILITARY ORDERS.

1 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2       **Section 1. Findings and Intent.** *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* finds that spouses  
3 of active duty armed forces personnel who are residents of Guam who leave Guam  
4 and return home have encountered difficulty in renewing their expired Guam  
5 driver's license.

6       *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* affirms that in service to our Nation these families  
7 upon returning home should be exempted from having to endure the entire process  
8 of having to obtain a valid Guam driver's license if they can show proof of active  
9 military orders stateside or abroad.

10       *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* finds that driver's licenses of spouses should remain  
11 valid despite the expiration date up to ninety-one (91) days upon their return home

12 without penalty in having to re-take the required driver's license written  
13 examination and road courses.

14 **Section 2. Effect of Military Service.** A new subsection (c) is hereby  
15 added to § 3101.2 of Chapter 3, Title 16, Guam Code Annotated to read:

16 "(c) Spouses of active duty military personnel shall be exempted from any  
17 penalties upon renewing their Guam driver's license upon returning to Guam from  
18 military orders stateside or abroad. Spouses shall be exempted under this Title  
19 from being required to retake a written test or road examination. Spouses of active  
20 duty military personnel who possess a Guam driver's license notwithstanding the  
21 expiration date of the license shall be deemed valid up to ninety-one (91) days  
22 upon returning to Guam and shall show proof of military orders to obtain an  
23 exemption."

24 **Section 3. Severability.** If any provision of this Law or its application to  
25 any person or circumstance is found to be invalid or contrary to law, such  
26 invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications, and to this end the  
27 provisions of the law are severable.
