

AN ACT TO ADD A NEW § 26705 TO ARTICLE 7 OF CHAPTER 26, TITLE 11, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, AS ADDED BY PUBLIC LAW 34-87; RELATIVE TO EXEMPTING BASIC NEED PRODUCTS FROM THE GENERAL SALES TAX; AND TO CITE THIS ACT AS THE "WORKING FAMILIES RELIEF ACT."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

- Section 1. Short Title. This Act shall be cited as the "Working Families Relief
- 3 Act."

- Section 2. To add a new § 26705 to Article 7 of Chapter 26, Title 11, GCA,
- 5 as added by Public Law 34-87, to read:
- 6 "§ 26705. Exemptions. The sale of uncooked foods, pharmaceuticals,
- 7 diapers, and feminine hygiene products shall be exempted from the General Sales
- 8 Tax levied under § 26701 of this Chapter. For the purpose of this section, uncooked
- 9 foods shall mean raw fruits, vegetables, eggs, fish, and meat; pharmaceuticals shall
- mean drugs as defined in 10 GCA § 40102, including prescription drugs and over-
- 11 the-counter drugs; diapers shall include baby diapers and adult incontinence
- products; and feminine hygiene products shall include any product used by woman
- to manage menstrual hygiene."
- Section 2. Effective Date. This Act shall be effective upon enactment.
