AN ACT TO AMEND §§ 28202 (a) AND 28202 (c) OF ARTICLE 2, CHAPTER 28, OF TITLE 17, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO THE TUITION AND FEES BENEFIT FOR MERIT AWARD RECIPIENTS UNDER THE STUDENT FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAM FOR HIGHER EDUCATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. Use of Pell Grant and Student Financial Assistance Fund.

§28202 (a) of Article 2, Chapter 28, of Title 17, Guam Code Annotated, is *amended* to read:

“§28202 **Benefits.** Students entitled to awards pursuant to this Article shall receive the following benefits:

- (a) **Tuition and Fees at University of Guam.** Tuition and fees for each academic year to be paid by the Student Financial Assistance Fund for a period of not more than four (4) years in an undergraduate program at the University of Guam; except, that merit award recipients who are eligible to receive the Federal Pell Grant (Higher Education Act of 1965, as amended, Title IV, Part A, Subpart 1; 20 U.S.C. 1070a) shall have their Pell Grant applied to their tuition and fees charges for each Financial Assistance Fund. Expenditure from the Student Financial Assistance Fund shall be equal to the remaining balance of a recipient's tuition and

fees after subtracting the recipient's Federal Pell Grant award for the academic year."

Section 2. Allowance for Textbooks and School Supplies. §28202 (c) of Article 2, Chapter 28, of Title 17, Guam Code Annotated, is *amended* to read:

“(c) Allowance for Textbooks and School Supplies. Each student receiving an award under this Article shall be entitled to an additional Three Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$350.00) per semester for textbooks and school supplies.”
