**AN ACT TO ADD A NEW § 122530 TO ARTICLE 25 OF CHAPTER 12, TITLE 10, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO GRANTING WAIVER AUTHORITY TO THE GOVERNOR OF GUAM FOR CERTAIN REQUIRMENTS RELATED TO LABORATORIES AND DISPENSARIES, AS THOSE REQUIREMENTS ARE SET OUT IN THE JOAQUIN (KC) CONCEPCION II COMPASSIONATE CANNABIS USE ACT 2013” .**

1           **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2           **Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent.** *I Liheslaturan Guåhan*  
3 find that the successful enactment of “The Joaquin (KC) Concepcion II  
4 Compassionate Cannabis Use Act of 2013” has stalled. *I Liheslaturan*  
5 *Guåhan* has diligently provided legislation as issues arise but the timeliness  
6 of the legislative process causes significant delays to the successful  
7 fulfillment of the “The Joaquin (KC) Concepcion II Compassionate  
8 Cannabis Use Act of 2013.”

9           Therefore it is the intent of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* to authorize the  
10 governor of Guam to waive, by way of executive orders, certain  
11 requirements that may arise during the course of the implementation of “The  
12 Joaquin (KC) Concepcion II Compassionate Cannabis Use Act of 2013.”

13           **Section 2. A new § 122530 is hereby added to Article 25 of Chapter**  
14 **12, Title 10, Guam Code Annotated, to read:**

15           **§ 122530. Executive Waiver Authority.**

1           The Governor of Guam is authorized to waive, by way of executive  
2 orders, requirements related to laboratories and dispensaries that are engaged  
3 or will be engaged in the medicinal cannabis program envisaged in “The  
4 Joaquin (KC) Concepcion II Compassionate Cannabis Use Act of 2013.”  
5 Any such waiver *shall* only take effect after thirty (30) days from the date of  
6 the filing of any such executive order with the Speaker of *I Liheslaturan*  
7 *Guåhan*. Any such executive order *shall* contain an explanation of the need  
8 for the waiver, which must include an explanation of why existing  
9 requirements impede or otherwise obstruct fulfillment of “The Joaquin (KC)  
10 Concepcion II Compassionate Cannabis Use Act of 2013.” Within thirty (30)  
11 days of the filing of any such waiver with the Speaker of *I Liheslaturan*  
12 *Guåhan*, *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* may pass a legislative resolution rejecting  
13 in part or in whole the Governor’s waiver, such duly passed legislative  
14 resolution shall deem such executive waiver null and void.

15           **Section 3. Effective Date.** This Act *shall* be effective upon  
16 enactment.
