AN ACT RELATIVE TO ESTABLISHING EDUCATION, HEALTH AND PUBLIC SAFETY AS THE TOP PRIORITIES OF THE GOVERNMENT, TO FACILITATING THE GOVERNOR'S REORGANIZATION AUTHORITY OF THE EXECUTIVE BRANCH OF THE GOVERNMENT AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES; AND TO CITE THIS ACT AS THE "GOVERNMENT PRIORITIES ACT OF 2017.

## **1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

Section 1. Short title. This Act may be cited as the *Government Priorities Act of 2017.*

Section 2. Legislative Findings and Intent. I Liheslaturan Guåhan finds 4 that preparing our youth for the future through education, fostering the health of the 5 6 people and ensuring safety for all are the most important functions of the executive branch of the government of Guam. These functions must be accomplished even if, 7 in these times of scarce resources, some other activities of government must be 8 greatly reduced or eliminated altogether. By enacting the Government Priorities Act 9 of 2017, I Liheslatura intends to facilitate this prioritization while giving full 10 recognition to the Governor's Organic Act authority to reorganize the executive 11 12 branch of the government of Guam.

13 *I Liheslatura* finds that the use by *I Maga'låhen Guåhan* of an established 14 order of priority among the various agencies, instrumentalities, and public corporations of the executive branch would greatly facilitate the exercise by the
 Governor of his reorganization authority for the purposes of this Act.

This Act recognizes education, health and public safety as the government's top priorities so that the Governor may establish priorities among government agencies so that the top priorities are adequately funded.

6 I Liheslatura further finds that the Governor use these tools, to include outsourcing, privatization, elimination of agencies, absorption of functions, 7 prioritization of personnel and appropriations, to provide a smaller, more affordable 8 9 government which, if nothing else, provides for education, health and public safety. While allowing transfer of appropriations when agencies are abolished or functions 10 relocated, I Liheslatura continues to reserve to itself its plenary power of 11 appropriation and its power to create agencies and departments. It 12 is therefore the intent of the Legislature to mandate that the Governor establish this 13 order of priority, by way of executive order, and in a manner consistent with these 14 15 findings.

Section 3. Notwithstanding any other law, rule, or regulation to the 16 17 contrary, I Maga'låhen Guåhan may, by executive order, reorganize the various agencies, instrumentalities, and public corporations of the executive branch of the 18 government of Guam, provided that I Maga'låhen Guåhan shall first establish an 19 order of priority, and provided further that said order of priority shall incorporate I 20 21 Liheslatura's findings that education, health, and safety are the most vital 22 governmental functions that must be safeguarded at all times, including during a 23 certified emergency. A certified emergency is any emergency posing an imminent threat to public health, welfare, or safety which could not have been foreseen through 24 the use of reasonable and prudent management procedures, and which is certified in 25 writing to exist by I Maga'låhen Guåhan. Said reorganization authority shall include 26 27 the authority of the I Maga'låhen Guåhan to transfer, in whole or in part, both the

funds and the functions of any one agency, instrumentality, or public corporation of the executive branch to any other agency, instrumentality, or public corporation of the executive branch, and *shall* further include the authority to abolish, consolidate, or otherwise reorganize said entities.

Section 4. Notwithstanding any other law, rule or regulation to the contrary, *I Maga'låhen Guåhan shall* transmit the order of priority called for in Section 3 of
this Act to the Speaker of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan no later than* ninety (90) days from
enactment of this Act.

9 Section 5. Notwithstanding any other law, rule, or regulation to the contrary, 10 any executive order effectuating reorganization under this Act *shall* immediately 11 terminate upon termination of the certified emergency which gave rise to said 12 executive order.

Section 6. Severability. If any provision of this law or its application to any person or circumstance is found to be invalid or contrary to law, such invalidity *shall not* affect other provisions or applications of this law that can be given effect without the invalid provisions or application, and to this end the provisions of this law are severable.
