## BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

- Section 1. § 1105 of Chapter 1, Title 2, Guam Code Annotated is amended
- 3 to read:

- 4 "§ 1105. Senators, Terms of.
- 5 Senators elected to the Guam Legislature shall hold office for a term of two
- 6 (2) four (4) years and until their successors are elected and qualified. There shall be
- 7 no limit to the number of terms an individual may serve on a lifetime basis, except
- 8 that an individual *shall not* serve more than three (3) terms on a consecutive basis.
- 9 The term of Senators elected to the Guam Legislature shall commence on the first
- 10 Monday of January following the date of election."
- 11 Section 2. Effective Date.
- This act *shall* be effective upon the next general election after enactment.
