BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. § 1105 of Chapter 1, Title 2, Guam Code Annotated is *amended* to read:

“§ 1105. Senators, Terms of.

Senators elected to the Guam Legislature shall hold office for a term of ~~two~~ (2) four (4) years and until their successors are elected and qualified. There shall be no limit to the number of terms an individual may serve on a lifetime basis, except that an individual shall not serve more than three (3) terms on a consecutive basis. The term of Senators elected to the Guam Legislature shall commence on the first Monday of January following the date of election.”

Section 2. Effective Date.

This act *shall* be effective upon the next general election after enactment.
