AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE ONE MILLION TWO TWENTY-NINE HUNDRED **THOUSAND** FIVE HUNDRED THIRTY-THREE DOLLARS (\$1,229,533) FROM THE FISCAL YEAR 2020 BUDGET TO THE DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS FOR OVERTIME COMPENSATION OF **DEPARTMENT** OF CORRECTIONS EMPLOYEES UNDER CIVIL CASE NO. CV1360-10.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent.

I Liheslaturan Guåhan finds that the services provided by public safety and law enforcement personnel are critical to the needs of the island and that the intent to sufficiently recruit and retain of the individuals who perform this vital service has been hampered by insufficient and untimely compensation.

I Liheslatura also finds that public safety officials and law enforcement personnel who work overtime shifts shall be compensated the full amount that they are entitled under the Minimum Wage and Hour Act of Guam. Overtime rates are one and one-half times regular rate of pay for all hours worked over forty (40) hours in one week, as provided by § 3107 of the Minimum Wage and Hour Act of Guam, codified at 22 GCA §§ 3101 through 3121.

I Liheslatura further finds that on August 13, 2010, plaintiffs filed a Complaint for Declaratory Judgment and Preliminary and Permanent Injunctive Relief "on behalf of themselves and those similarly situated whom are Department of Corrections employees." The Honorable Alberto C. Lamorena III granted the plaintiffs' request for an order to show cause and set the matter for hearing on August 27, 2010. The Court entered a judgment to compensate the plaintiffs and those similarly situated until all are fully paid for all claims and wages forth herein.

I Liheslatura finds that under Civil Case No. CV 1360-10, two hundred four (204) Department of Corrections employees shall be compensated for work completed to include overtime pay, night differential pay, and hazardous pay. The amount of judgment to date including all interest is One Million Two Hundred Twenty-Nine Thousand Five Hundred Thirty-Three Dollars (\$1,229,533).

Therefore, it is the intent of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* to appropriate One Million Two Hundred Twenty-Nine Thousand Five Hundred Thirty-Three Dollars (\$1,229,533) from the Fiscal Year 2020 Budget to the Department of Corrections.

Section 2. Appropriation from the Fiscal Year 2020 Budget to the Guam Department of Corrections. The unrestricted amount of One Million Two Hundred Twenty-Nine Thousand Five Hundred Thirty-Three Dollars (\$1,229,533) *shall* be appropriated to the Guam Department of Corrections from the Fiscal Year 2020 Budget and *shall* be used to fund overtime compensation for the two hundred four (204) Department of Corrections employees entitled to such compensation per Civil Case No. CV 1360-10.

Section 3. Severability. If any provision of this Act or its application to any person or circumstance is found to be invalid or contrary to law, such invalidity *shall not* affect other provisions or applications of this Act that can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this Act are severable.
