**AN ACT TO *AMEND* § 26603(d)(1) OF ARTICLE 6,
CHAPTER 26, DIVISION 2, TITLE 11, GUAM CODE
ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO HEALTHY FUTURES
FUND PROCEEDS AUTHORIZED FOR THE GUAM
MEMORIAL HOSPITAL AUTHORITY LINE OF
CREDIT.**

1 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2 **Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent.**

3 *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* finds that P.L. 30-166, which was signed into law on
4 July 16, 2010, inadvertently references 10GCA, § 80104(t) with respect to a Line
5 of Credit authorized for the Guam Memorial Hospital Authority (GMHA). The
6 intent of P.L. 30-166 was to utilize the Healthy Futures Fund to create a debt
7 service and bond payment funding source by allocating a portion of Healthy
8 Futures Fund proceeds to GMHA.

9 Recognizing that 10GCA, § 80104 prohibits GMHA from discriminating
10 against any individual or group for reasons of age, race, color, sex, national origin,
11 religious belief, marital status, physical/mental disability, political affiliation and
12 retaliation, it is the intent of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* to reference the right section of

1 10 GCA and ensure GMHA is able to seek a Line of Credit as may be necessary
2 and authorized by law.

4 **Section 2.** § 26603(d)(1) of Article 6, Chapter 26, Division 2, Title 11,
5 Guam Code Annotated, is *amended* to read:

6 “(d) Creation of the Healthy Futures Fund. There is hereby created the
7 Healthy Futures Fund (Fund) which shall be maintained separate and apart from
8 other funds of the government of Guam and shall be kept in a separate bank
9 account and shall not be subject to any transfer authority of *I Maga’lahen Guåhan*.

10 (1) The sum of One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000) of the taxes
11 collected pursuant to this Section shall be allocated and is appropriated, and
12 shall continue to be deemed appropriated annually to the Guam Memorial
13 Hospital Authority for the sole and specific purpose of funding for the line
14 of credit pursuant to § ~~80104~~80109(s), Chapter 80 Division 4, Title 10,
15 Guam Code Annotated.

16 (2) The annual allocation of One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000), as
17 appropriated pursuant to this Subsection (d), shall continue and shall remain
18 in full force and effect until specifically revoked or amended pursuant to
19 law.”

21 **Section 3. Severability.** *If* any provision of this Act or the application to
22 any person or circumstance is found to be invalid or contrary to law, such
23 invalidity *shall not* affect other provisions or applications of this Act that can be
24 given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the
25 provisions of this Act are severable.
