1 **AN ACT TO *AMEND* SECTION 8 OF CHAPTER XI,**
2 **PUBLIC LAW 34-116, RELATIVE TO REDUCING THE**
3 **GUAM RETIREMENT SECURITY PLAN**
4 **APPROPRIATION BY TWO HUNDRED THOUSAND**
5 **DOLLARS (\$200,000); AND APPROPRIATING THE**
6 **SAME FROM THE GENERAL FUND IN FISCAL YEAR**
7 **2019 TO THE GUAM POLICE DEPARTMENT FOR**
8 **SECURITY CAMERAS AND RELATED EQUIPMENT.**

11 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

12 **Section 1.** Section 8 of Chapter XI, Public Law 34-116, is hereby *amended*
13 to read:

14 **“Section 8. Guam Retirement Security Plan.** The sum of One
15 Thousand Four Hundred Sixty-Four Dollars (**\$1,464.00**) is hereby appropriated
16 from the General Fund to fund the Guam Retirement Security Plan established by
17 Public Law 33-186.”

18 **Section 2. Appropriation to the Guam Police Department.** The sum of
19 Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (**\$200,000**) is hereby appropriated from the
20 General Fund in Fiscal Year 2019 to the Guam Police Department to assist with
21 the deterrence and reporting of criminal activity. Funds *shall* be used to purchase,
22 operate, and maintain security cameras and related equipment in public areas.
23 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, this appropriation *shall* continue to be

1 available until September 30, 2019, and is not subject to transfer for use for any
2 other purpose.

3 **Section 3. Severability.** If any provision of this Act or its application to any
4 person or circumstance is found to be invalid or contrary to law, such invalidity
5 *shall not* affect other provisions or applications of this Act that can be given effect
6 without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
7 Act are severable.
