






**AN ACT TO AMEND § 2104 OF CHAPTER 2, TITLE 5,
GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO
EXPANDING THE SCOPE OF THE ISLAND
BEAUTIFICATION TASK FORCE.**

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. § 2104 of Chapter 2, Title 5, Guam Code Annotated is hereby
amended to read:

“§ 2104. Beautification Task Force.

(a) The Lt. Governor shall appoint an Islandwide Beautification Task Force,
consisting of:

- (1) the Director of the Guam Visitors Bureau;
- (2) the Director of the Department of Public Works;
- (3) the Director of the Department of Parks and Recreation;
- (4) the Director of the Department of Agriculture;
- (5) the Director of the Department of Corrections (DEPCOR);
- (6) the Director of the Guam Environmental Protection Agency
(GEPA);

1 (7) one (1) member of the Mayors Council of Guam (MCOG) who is
2 appointed by MCOG;

3 (8) and other members as the chairperson shall deem necessary.

4 The Task Force shall be under the direction of the Office of the Lt.
5 Governor, who shall serve as Chairperson of the Task Force.

6 (b) The Task Force shall work in conjunction with the Mayors' Council and
7 existing government agencies and private individuals and organizations to beautify
8 and promote Guam. Its function shall include, but not be limited to, the coordination
9 of efforts for:

10 (1) the clearing of overgrown weeds or trees;

11 (2) the planting of plants or flowers, especially native flora; and

12 (3) the restoration of graffiti inflicted structures along the island's
13 highways and scenic areas;

14 (4) implementing other beautification projects;

15 (5) preventing littering, preventing the illegal disposal of waste at
16 unauthorized sites, and preventing the destruction of public facilities,
17 including parks and beaches;

18 (6) establishing education, training, or programs of the same; and

19 (7) addressing other pertinent issues.

20 (c) The Task Force shall purchase only those horticultural products grown on
21 Guam.”
