**AN ACT TO CREATE A NEW CHAPTER 2 TO TITLE 12,
GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO SALARY
ADJUSTMENTS FOR EMPLOYEES APPOINTED BY
BOARDS AND COMMISSIONS OF AUTONOMOUS
AGENCIES OF THE GOVERNMENT OF GUAM.**

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. A new Chapter 2 of Title 12, Guam Code Annotated, is created
to read:

“CHAPTER 2

SALARY ADJUSTMENTS BY BOARDS AND COMMISSIONS

§ 2101. Salary adjustment: Lay before provision. No salary
adjustment for employees of autonomous agencies who are appointed by a
Board or Commission *shall* be effective until the certificate of the Chair of the
Board or Commission has lain before the legislature for ninety (90) days.

§ 2102. Same: Procedure. The resolution providing for a salary
adjustment for any employees appointed by a Board or Commission *shall*
upon adoption be transmitted to the Speaker of *i Liheslaturan Guåhan* along
with the certificate of the Chair *no later than* ninety (90) days before *i*
Liheslatura adjourns *sine die*.

1 **§ 2103. Contents of certificate.** The certificate of the Chair must
2 be executed pursuant to § 4308, Title 6, Guam Code Annotated. The
3 certificate must state that the resolution providing for the salary adjustment
4 was discussed and adopted in a properly called and noticed open and public
5 meeting, a quorum being present, and minutes being recorded.

6 **§ 2104. Same: Reporting.** The certificate of the Chair must show
7 that the requirements of § 8113.1, Title 5, Guam Code Annotated, have been
8 complied with.

9 **§ 2105. Salary adjustment void.** Attempted salary adjustments
10 not in compliance with the provisions of this chapter are void *ab initio*.”

11 **Section 2. Effective Date.** This Act *shall* be effective upon enactment.

12 **Section 3. Severability.** If any provision of this Act or its application to any
13 person or circumstance is found to be invalid or contrary to law, such invalidity *shall*
14 *not* affect other provisions or applications of this Act that can be given effect without
15 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this Act are
16 severable.
