AN ACT TO AMEND PUBLIC LAW 34-116, RELATIVE TO ENSURING ORGANIZATIONS THAT STRENGTHEN, ENHANCES, AND PRMOTE OUR TOURISM INDUSTRY ARE FUNDED.

1	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:
2	Section 1. Section 3 of Chapter X of Public Law 34-116 is amended to read:
3	"Section 3. Authority to Allocate to Organizations. For Fiscal Year
4	2019, the Board of Directors of the Guam Visitors Bureau may shall allocate
5	not more than the sums appropriated or allocated in Fiscal Year 2018 from
6	the appropriation in Section 1 of this Chapter, to any or all of the following
7	organizations:

11	Section 2.	A new Section 6 is added to Chapter X of Public Law 34-116 to

13	"Section 6.	Service and Reporting Requirements.
14	<u>(a)</u>	Organizations receiving funding from the TAF shall provide
15	community	service in the amount of ten (10) hours of service per One
16	Thousand D	Oollars (\$1,000) appropriated to them for activities and/or events.
17	These comm	nunity services shall be provided pursuant to the respective TAF
18	appropriation	ons. The Guam Visitors Bureau, in coordination with the General
19	Manager of	the Chamorro Village, shall establish procedures for certifying
20	community	service hours and issuing community service hour certification
21	reports.	
22	<u>(b)</u>	All organizations that receive funding from the TAF pursuant to
23	this Act sha	ll provide a budgetary breakdown by object category to the Guam
24	<u>Visitors Bur</u>	eau. These organizations shall attest under penalty of perjury that
25	they are med	eting the requirements of this Section.
26	<u>(c)</u>	Quarterly expenditure reports and community service hour
27	certification	reports shall be submitted to the Guam Visitors Bureau, who

1	shall then compile and submit said reports to I Liheslaturan Guåhan (the
2	Guam Legislature) on a quarterly basis.
3	(d) All research reports, literature, books, brochures, pamphlets, or similar
4	documents, including, but not limited to, mobile applications and software produced
5	using funds from the TAF shall be made accessible to the Guam Visitors Bureau."
6	Section 3. Effective date. This Act shall be effective upon enactment.
7	Section 4. Severability. If any provision of this Act or its application to any
8	person or circumstance is found to be invalid or contrary to law, such invalidity shall
9	not affect other provisions or applications of this Act that can be given effect without
10	the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this Act are

severable.
