AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE SIX MILLION DOLLARS (\$6,000,000.00) FROM THE HEALTH FUTURES FUND TO THE GUAM MEMORIAL HOSPITAL AUTHORITY FOR THEIR POWER UPGRADE PROJECT, INCLUSIVE OF THE REPLACEMENT AND INSTALLATION OF A NEW ELECTRICAL PANEL.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

- 2 Section 1. Appropriation. The sum of Six Million Dollars (\$6,000,000.00)
- 3 is appropriated from the Fiscal Year 2017 audited available fund balance of the
- 4 Healthy Future Fund in Fiscal Year 2019 to the Guam Memorial Hospital
- 5 Authority (GMHA) for their Power Upgrade Project, inclusive of the replacement
- 6 and installation of a new electrical panel. Notwithstanding any other provision of
- 7 law, this appropriation shall continue to be available until September 30, 2020, and
- 8 is not subject to transfer or use by any other purpose.
- 9 Section 2. Severability. If any provision of this Act or its application to
- 10 any person or circumstance is found to be invalid or contrary to law, such
- invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of this Act that can be
- 12 given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the
- provisions of this Act are severable.

1 Section 3. Effective Date. The Act shall become effective upon enactment.
