AN ACT TO ADD A NEW (5) TO (m) OF CHAPTER V, IN PUBLIC LAW 35-36, RELATIVE TO ESTABLISHING THE RATE OF STIPEND FOR GUAM POLICE DEPARTMENT CIVILIAN VOLUNTEER POLICE RESERVISTS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent. *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* finds that
the Guam Police Department has instituted a Civilian Volunteer Police Reserve
program that augments the work of the men and women in blue who serve our island
community daily providing support whenever a call for help is made and, since the
inception of this reserve program, volunteers have provided thousands of service
hours in the protection of life and property; by preventing crime, enforcing the laws
and maintaining order for all citizens. *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* further finds that an administrative oversight occured

I Liheslaturan Guåhan further finds that an administrative oversight occured when language in the Fiscal Year 2020 Budget Bill to establish the rate of compensation for reservists was not included.

Therefore, it is the intent of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* to ensure that these civilian volunteers are compensated for the time and efforts they exert in ensuring the safety and security of our island with a commensurate stipend for their contributions.

- Section 2. A new (5) is *added* to (m) of Chapter V, in Public Law 36-35, to
- 2 read:
- 3 "(5) Guam Police Department Civilian Volunteer Police Reserve Stipends.
- 4 The Guam Police Department shall compensate each volunteer serving in the
- 5 Civilian Volunteer Police Reserve program who fulfills the requirements for each
- 6 month's duty the amount of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) for that month,
- 7 effective October 1, 2020."
- 8 **Section 3.** Effective Date. This Act *shall* become effective upon enactment.
