AN ACT TO AMEND § 8104 OF ARTICLE 1, CHAPTER 8, TITLE 4, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO IDENTIFYING DEPARTMENT OF YOUTH AFFAIRS PEACE OFFICER AS A MEMBER OF THE UNIFORMED PERSONNEL COMMUNITY

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent.

I Liheslaturan Guåhan finds that uniformed personnel are afforded the opportunity to retire five (5) years earlier, based on age, than the typical public employee. It is therefore the intent of I Liheslaturan Guåhan to afford the same retirement opportunity to the uniformed personnel of the Department of Youth Affairs to maintain the integrity of the law enforcement community.

**Section 2.** § 8104 of Article 1, Chapter 8, Title 4, Guam Code Annotated is hereby *amended* to read:

## § 8104. Definitions.

(p) Uniformed Personnel means Guam Police Department Officers; Guam Fire Department Firemen; Customs and Quarantine Officers of the Customs and Quarantine Agency; Conservation Officers, Commodity Inspectors, and Entomologists of the Department of Agriculture; Territorial Park Patrol Officers of the Department of Parks and Recreation; Corrections Officers of the Department of

- 1 Corrections; Airport Police Officers and Security Personnel at the Antonio B. Won
- 2 Pat International Airport Authority, Guam; Jose D. Leon Guerrero Commercial
- 3 Port Security personnel; Marshals of the Supreme Court of Guam and the Superior
- 4 Court of Guam; Probation Officers of the Judiciary of Guam; and Firefighters of
- 5 the Antonio B. Won Pat International Airport Authority, Guam; and Peace Officers
- 6 with the Department of Youth Affairs engaged in juvenile detention and
- 7 <u>rehabilitation.</u> In all matters involving the uniformed personnel at the Antonio B.
- 8 Won Pat International Airport Authority, Guam, the Jose D. Leon Guerrero
- 9 Commercial Port, or the Department of Parks and Recreation, the Supreme Court
- 10 of Guam and the Superior Court of Guam Marshals, and the Guam Police
- Department shall have concurrent jurisdiction with such personnel.
- Section 3. Effective Date. All sections of this Act *shall* be effective upon enactment.
