AN ACT TO AMEND § 2103.4 (n) OF CHAPTER 2, TITLE 4, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO THE NINETY (90) DAY LIMIT OF ACTING APPOINTMENTS.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent.

I Liheslaturan Guåhan finds that appointments expire ninety (90) days from the date of initial acting appointment by the Governor or appointing officials, excluding intervening weekdays and holidays.

It is the intent of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* to clarify that the ninety (90) day limit shall mean ninety (90) calendar days.

**Section 2.** § 2103.4(n) of Chapter 2, Title 4, Guam Code Annotated, is amended to read:

# "§ 2103.4. Definitions.

(n) Ninety (90) days - in computing the ninety (90) day time limit imposed in this chapter, the term ninety (90) days shall mean ninety (90) <u>calendar</u> days from the date of the initial acting appointment, <u>without regard to weekends</u>, <u>holidays</u>, nor any lapses in the acting appointment of less than thirty (30) days."

**Section 3. Severability.** If any provision of this Act or its application to any person or circumstance is found to be invalid or contrary to law, such invalidity *shall not* affect other provisions or applications of this Act that can be given effect without

- the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this Act are
- 2 severable.
- Section 4. Effective Date. This act shall be effective upon enactment.
